Bur Oak Secondary School Grade 10 Applied English ENG 2P1

Course Description

As grade ten is the year students are required to write the O.S.S.L.T., this course seeks to especially strengthen student reading strategies and technical writing skills. Students, with teacher support, read two novels (Theories of Relativity and The Book of Michael) and complete a variety of writing tasks connected to their reading. Students will use their digital skills to produce a multi-media presentation and perform online research.

Reading Tasks: Students will develop their reading skills through teacher modeling of readaloud and think-aloud strategies. Students will also be expected to read and analyze a variety of online texts that are relevant to the social and political issues in their novels.

Writing Tasks: Students will use a journal for responding and brainstorming. This journal will contain rough drafts of scripts, monologues, character sketches, news stories, and essays. The use of electronic software to polish written work will be encouraged and supported as much as possible both in and out of the classroom.
