Approval of December 4, 2023 School Council Meeting Minutes

Student Council Update (Alice and Kelvin)

- December Winter Assembly: Talent Show, theme of Harry Potter

- Bur Oak lanyards, tote bags, sweaters – for purpose to be proud of school

- Spirit day bake sale - \$2 plushy, Valentine Day card write to friend, can adopt plushy, bake sale

Student Success Teacher and MLL Teacher – Kathy Brown

- support with transitions grade 8 to grade 9: visit elementary schools; grade 9 Day for students to be comfortable in school

- support students to be successful: advocacy and mentoring of students – be voice for student, pathways? Strategies to support student?

- provide direct instruction; e.g., difficulty in an assignment, how to unpack for student

- monitoring of students; have mid-semester and end-of-semester data; if having difficulty in a subject have conversation to help move forward

- staff and community development: support, answer questions; share strategies with whole staff

- examples of supports:

- tutoring Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays

- credit rescue: assignments incomplete – spend whole day in January working on an assignment to be reset i.e., rescue the credit

- credit recovery: student not successful in course – 35% and 45% can be recommended for credit recovery; can help student recover credit so not credit deficit

- check ins with students new to grade 9s in beginning of year, and will again start of semester 2

- bi-weekly meetings to discuss student needs: as student success team

- meet with students throughout out day to support

- meet with teachers and admin from elementary schools

- grade 9 Transition day

- Work as a team: admin, guidance, student services, settlement workers, admissions and student liaison officers, CYWs, school social worker, subject teachers, parents/guardians

- student success teacher is like a triage nurse – what can we do to support?

Question: Difference between guidance and student success – guidance can help with timetabling and career counselling, student success teacher can support students with academics

MLL – Multilingual Language Learners – Kathy Brown

Terminology: English as a Second Language (ESL) → English Language Learners (ELLs) → Multilingual Language Learners (MLLs)

MLL Teacher Support Teacher Responsibilities

- support classroom teacher to develop instructional or assessment strategies for MLLs – e.g., assessments accommodated for students at any level ESL

- can co-teach

- 2 classes: Drama and Geography which are all MLLs

- 10 minutes monthly at staff meeting
