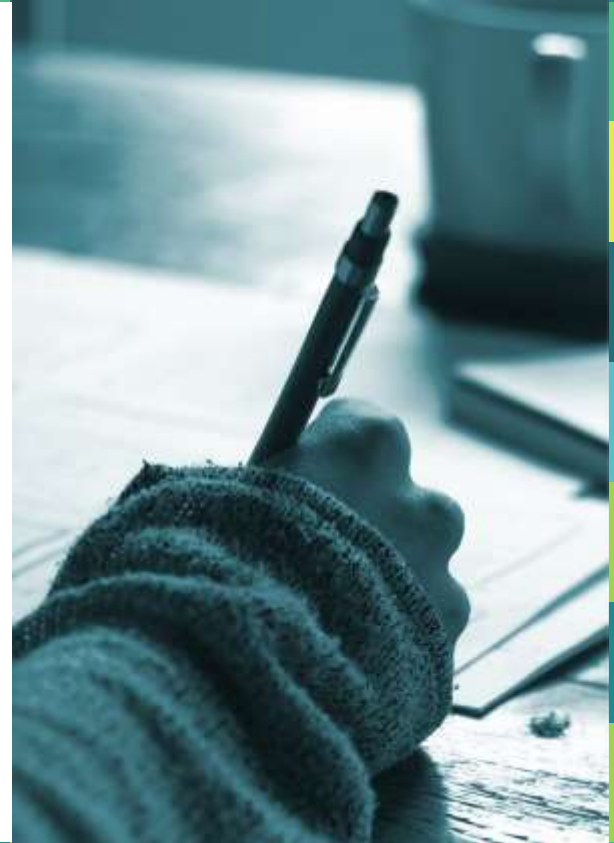

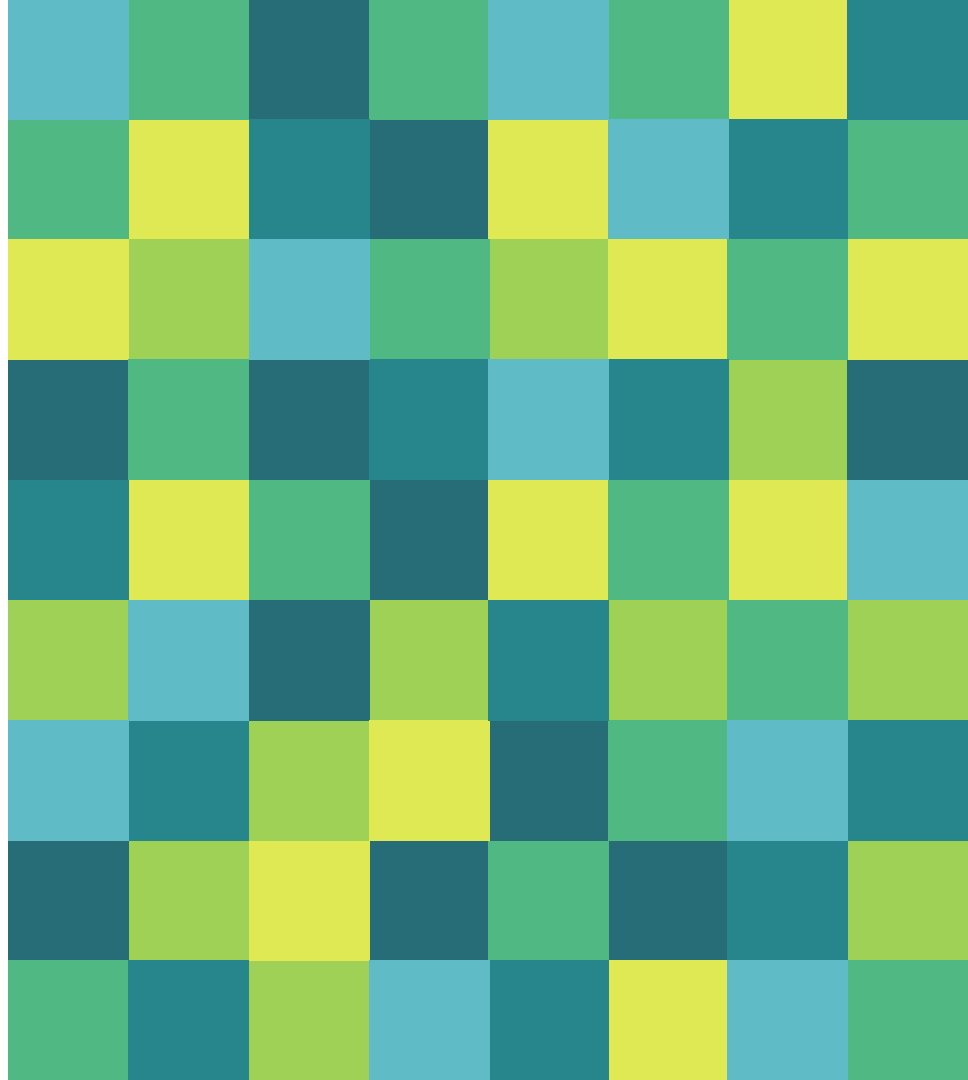

Attendance

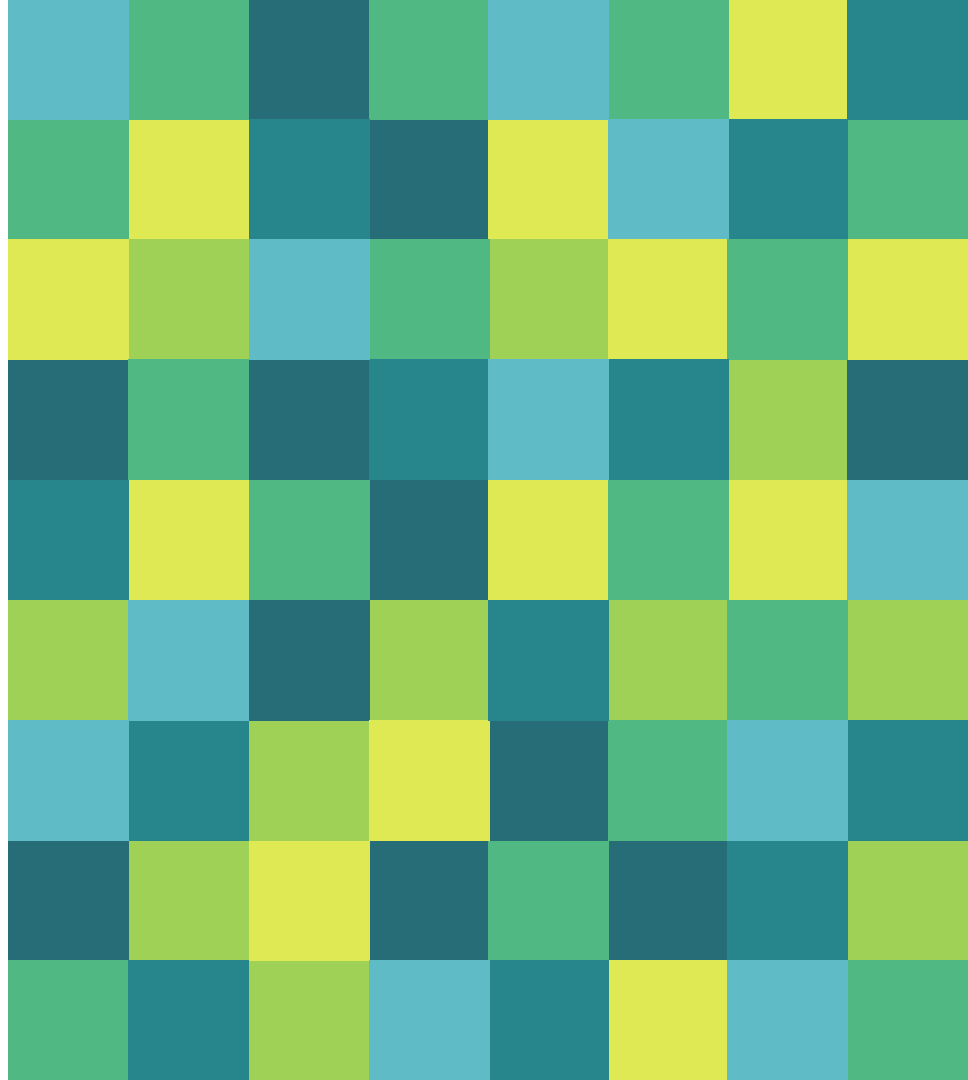
- Full time status

Post secondary Applications

OUAC--deadline has passed; will be a second round of applications in June

OCAS--ongoing application cycle after Feb 1 equal consideration (check to see if program OPEN)

Application follow-up

- **Read** all correspondence sent/check email messages/log in to specific portals
- **Be aware** of additional requirements and due dates for supplementary applications and/or interviews and portfolio reviews
- Pay special attention to deadlines

Dates to understand

No rocket science required!



Sem One Mark Upload and deadline	First week of February (have been sent)
Sem Two Mid term Marks	April
Semester Two Final Mark Upload	July
College Conditional Offers	As early as February 1 st until program is full or waitlisted
Due date: Acceptance of College	May 1 st (deposit by mid June)
University Conditional Offers	Offers ongoing until May 26th
Due date: Acceptance of University Program	June 1st

Mid term Marks (Semester 2)

BOSS is unable to “upload” mid-term marks that do not belong to York Region (unless another board)

E-learning, day school and night school automatic from York Region

Private schools must deal with their own mid term marks

They inform OUAC/OCAS of your enrolment and mark

Final marks can be entered by BOSS (due date)

Offers are Conditional

- Need to keep the “agreement” for conditions stated in your offer (usually end of June)
- Reference number or school number required in all correspondence
- Don't lose your password to OCAS/OUAC (you need this to accept your offer)

Grade 12 Worries--What happens if...

- I am not doing well in semester 2?
- I get an offer from a college before my university offer has arrived?
- my average is not that great.....maybe I can get my marks “bumped”??
- I don't receive any offers?
- Semester one was not so great....Is it too late to change my application?



What happens if I need to come back next year?

30 credits to graduate (as many credits as possible in 4 years)

34 credits** (up to another semester)

Additional credits possible in York Region with:

- E-learning, Night School, Summer School
- Independent Learning Centres, Adult Day School.

- English as a Second Language (ESL) core language courses

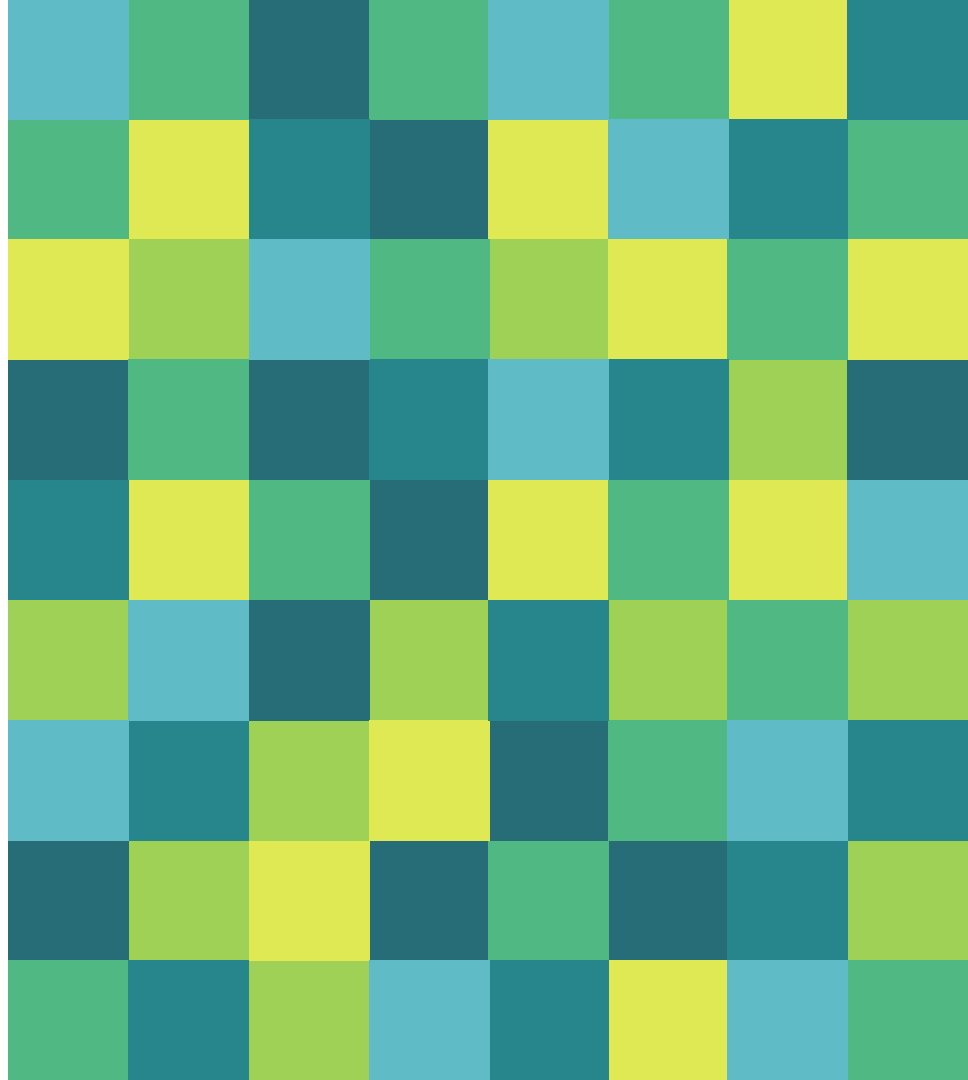

Graduation and Possible Issues



Still need another course?

- Registration for Night School and Night School e-Learning (courses start this week)
- Eligible if course is **NOT** available or full at BOSS
- Must remain full time, may need to repeat at BOSS

- Night school e-learning—registration closed on **Feb 15th (noon)**
- Day school e-learning—follow through with all assignments (especially if 3rd course)

Private School

- Will not drop a course due to PS enrollment (especially if makes you part time)
- Do not pay for a course until you have spoken with us
- Reminder: we can only add final marks to OUAC/OCAS
- Need final marks **BEFORE** before we send marks for uploading

External Credit Due dates

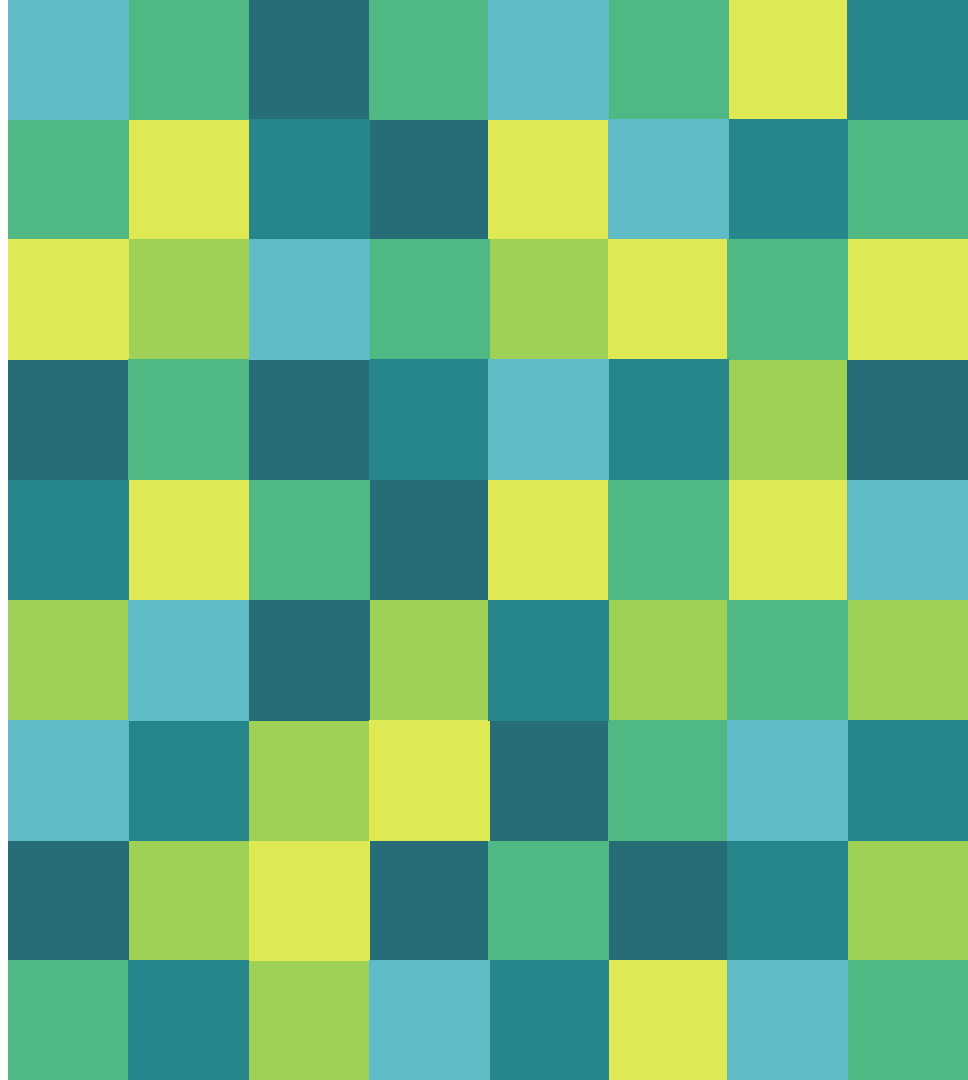
- Sealed envelope to guidance by Friday June 21st (this is for adding to transcript)

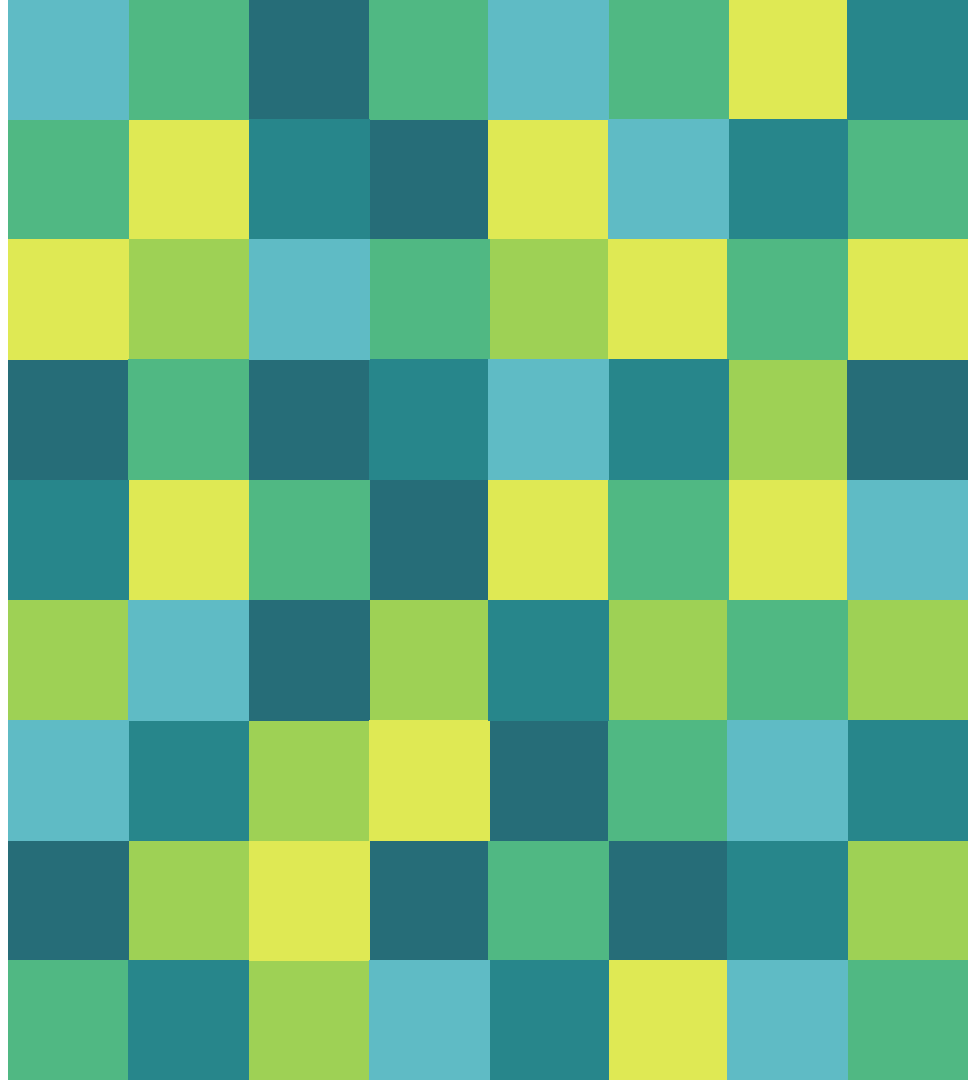
