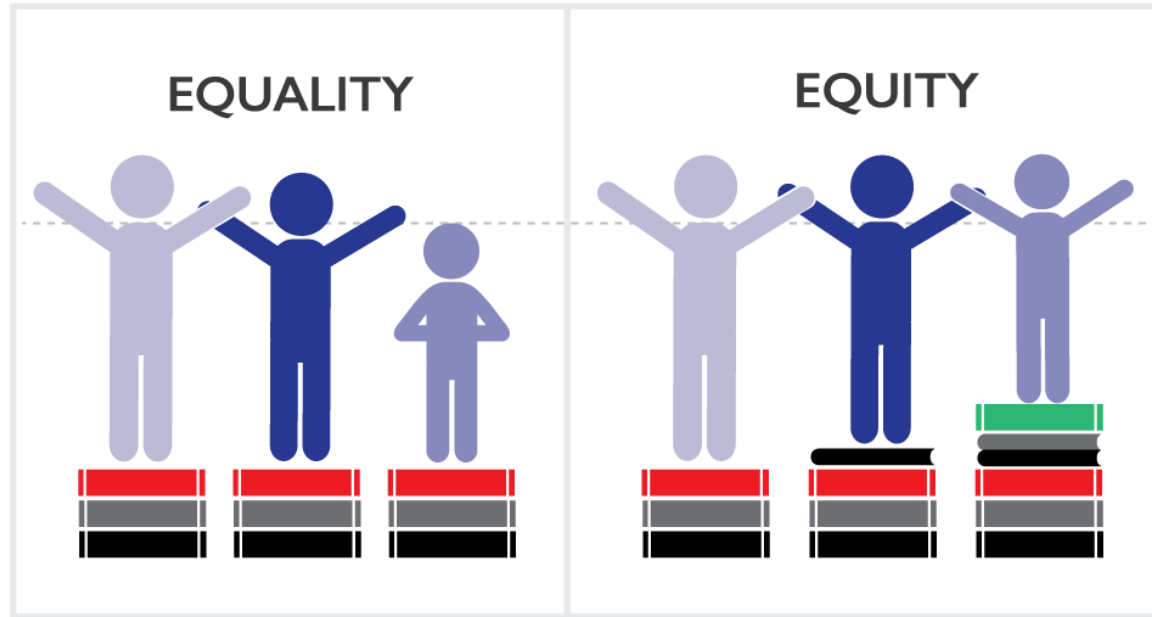






Progressive Discipline

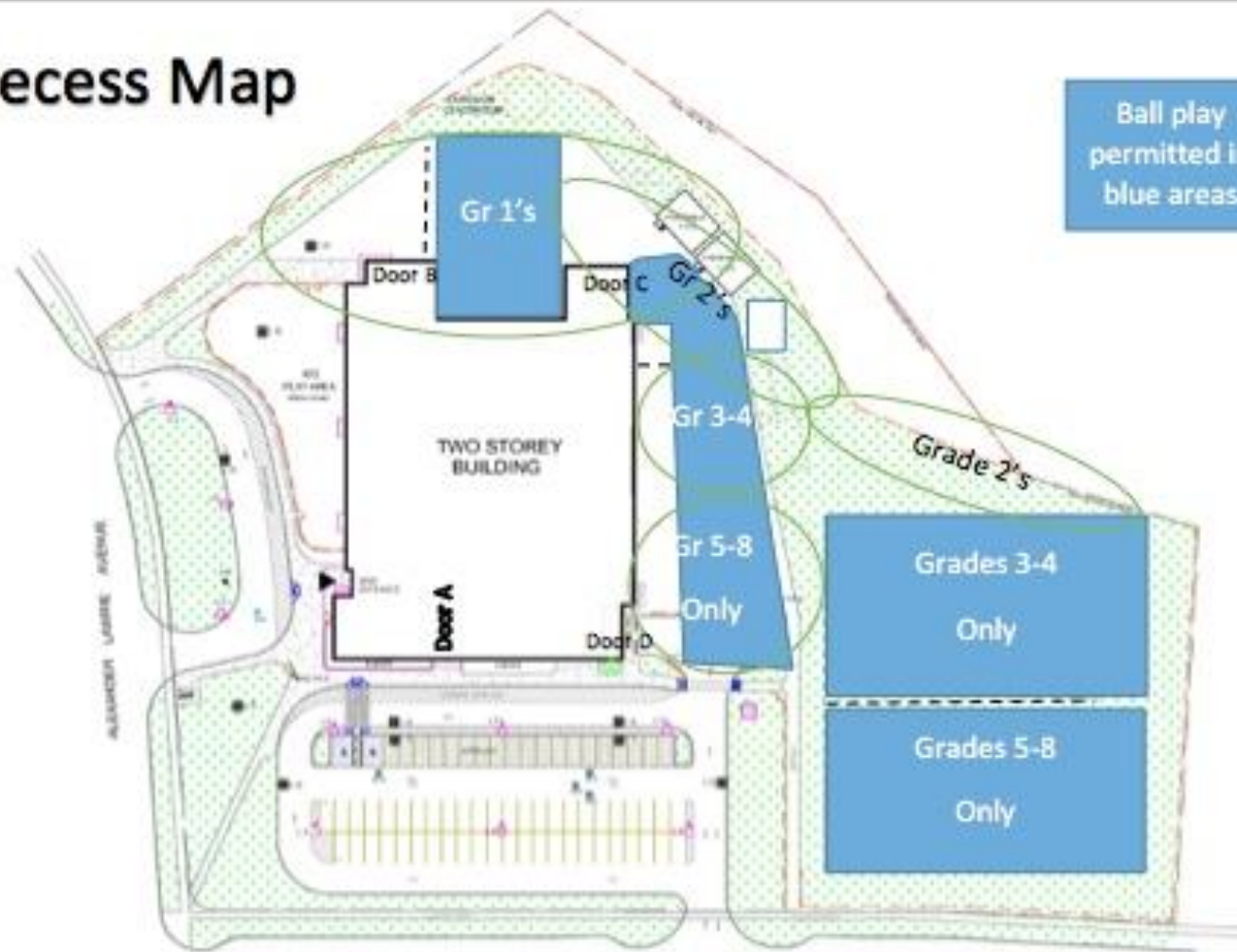
