**Please note:** If you are planning on using a previously purchased gown, please contact Mrs. Harrison (ext 185) as you will need to order an updated stole for this year's graduation.



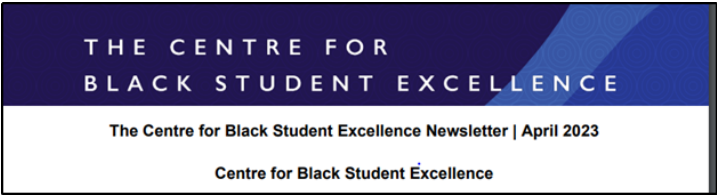

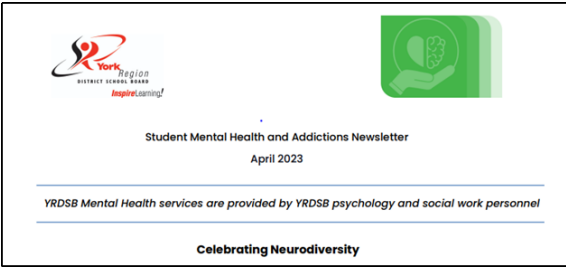
