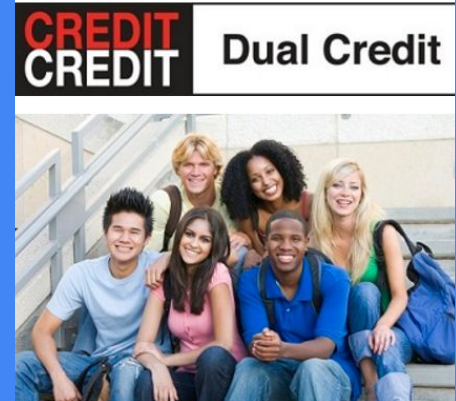


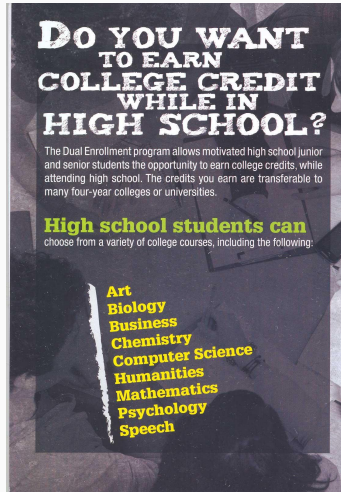

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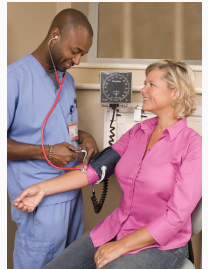
# College Delivered Dual Credit

# A good candidate for Dual Credit...

...is in gr. 11 or 12

...is looking to explore pathways for future careers.

...is looking to make connections between secondary school and their future to improve motivation and achievement overall

...is behind on their credit count

# A good candidate for Dual Credit...

## PATHWAYS

- is unsure of his or her pathway beyond secondary school;
- is in need of career clarification;
- sees little connection between secondary school and his or her preferred future;

## MOTIVATION

- was making progress earlier, but progress has slowed;
- is demonstrating a decline in achievement or marks over time.
- lacks confidence in his or her ability to succeed;

## DISENGAGED

- displays a lack of involvement or engagement in school or community activities;
- has had numerous absences;
- has previously dropped out or is at risk of dropping out;
- is out of school but is reluctant to return to secondary school for non-academic reasons;

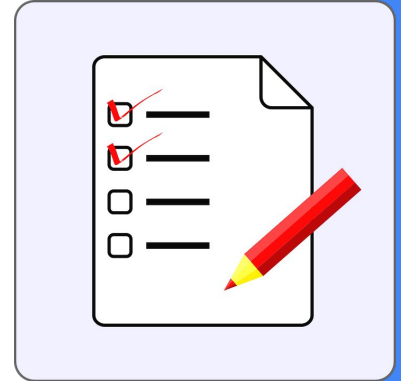
## CREDIT COUNT

- has fewer credits than average for his or her grade and is therefore not on track to graduate on time;
- is older than other students in his or her grade;

## Enrolled as an OYAP/Accelerated OYAP Student

*Note: In all cases, there should be evidence that a student has the potential to succeed*



# HOW TO APPLY: A two part process...

## 1. YRDSB Application

- Complete the **Online [YRDSB Dual Credit Student Application Form](#)**
- The completed application package will be emailed to you. Print this package out.
- Page 4 - Indicate mode of transportation you are planning to use
- Page 5 collect signatures of yourself and parent/guardian
- This application is to be returned to your school contact with the College Specific Application where they will fill out:
  - Page 3 for the criteria
  - Page 5 for Principal & School Contact signatures

## 2. College Specific Application

- Print the completed application form and media release form and collect signatures of yourself, your parents/guardian if applicable.
- This application is to be returned to your school contact
- Both of these packages will be scanned and sent by your school contact to the Dual Credit teacher Steph Parent at Bayview Secondary School
- You will then be contacted by the Dual Credit teacher



# A few more important points...

- ▶ Students are expected to have a 5th period lunch/spare so that they can travel to their dual credit class without missing day school courses
- ▶ Students should also expect to have 3 day school courses only
- ▶ There are some exceptions, please speak to a counsellor for more information
- ▶ Check emails/texts/voicemails as that is how the dual credit teacher will communicate specific course information (including start dates, orientation etc.)
