
- Growing enrolment
 - ➤ IB and Arts program






Existing and Proposed Langstaff Secondary School and **Alexander Mackenzie High School Boundaries**

Secondary Boundary




Timing and Students Impacted

Langstaff SS



Student Transfers

 Transfers are outlined in <u>Board Policy 108</u>: <u>Student Accommodation - Attendance</u>
 <u>Areas and Transfers</u>

 Schools open/closed to transfers is reviewed on an annual basis

Transportation (Policy 680.0)

- Transportation provided as per policy 680
 - ➤ Grades 9 to 12 a secondary school student living in an area served by public transit is not eligible for Board-provided transportation
 - ➤ A secondary student living more than 3.2 kilometres from the nearest secondary school in an area not served by public transit is eligible for Board-provided transportation
- School bus transportation eligibility is reviewed annually as York Region Transit (YRT) adjusts and enhances service
