




# Evaluation of Secondary School Location for New Program

\*\*Projections are based on assumptions of current rates of elementary student attendance to secondary schools, and pace of new residential development.


# Secondary FI Program

- Currently at Aurora HS since 1989
  - Only location serving Aurora and Oak Ridges
  - October 2017 French Immersion enrolment:

Grade 9	Grade 10	Grade 11	Grade 12	Total
160	128	112	113	513

- FI program is growing
- An additional FI secondary program is required due to:
  - Residential development
  - Growing enrolment from the elementary panel

# Proposed Secondary FI Boundary




# Timing and Students Impacted

## Aurora HS



  - Schools open/closed to transfers is reviewed on an annual basis

# Transportation (Policy 680.0)

- Secondary school students in Oak Ridges attending King City SS are currently bused
  - School bus transportation eligibility is reviewed annually as York Region Transit (YRT) adjusts and enhances service
