  - French Immersion program

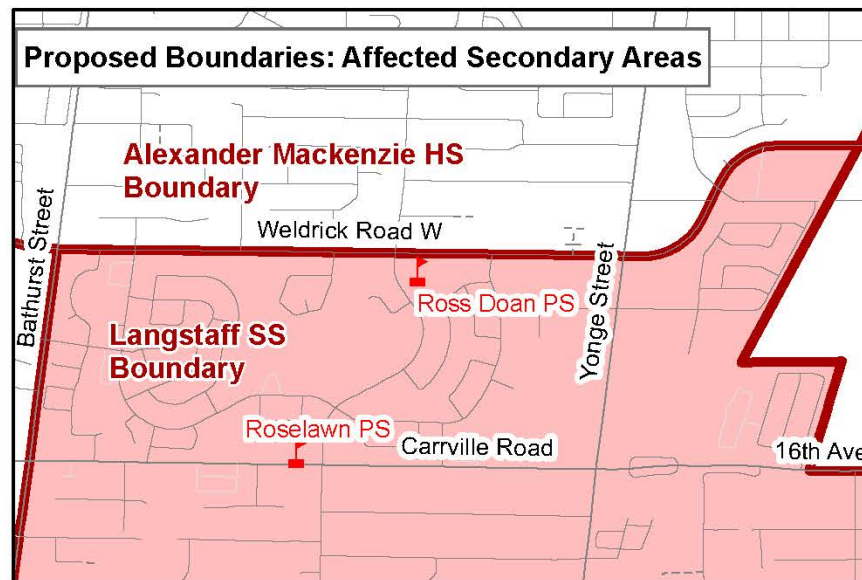
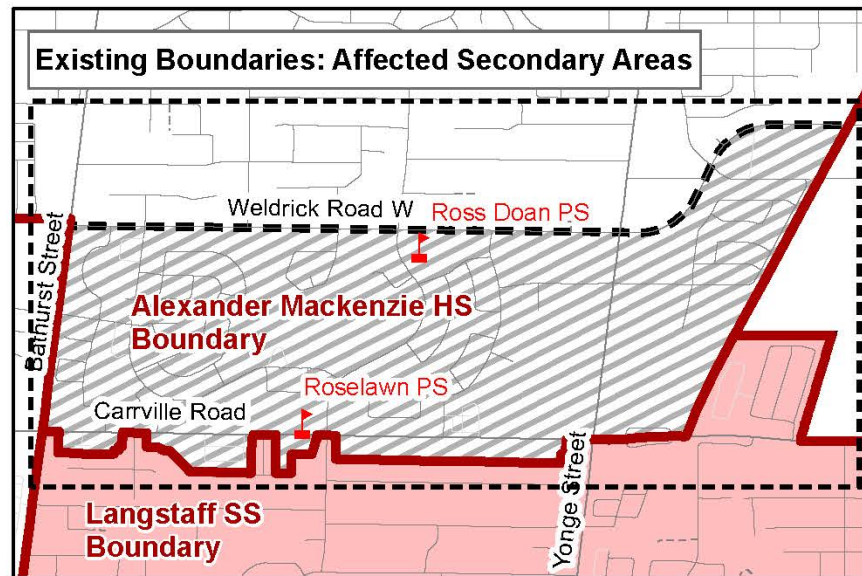
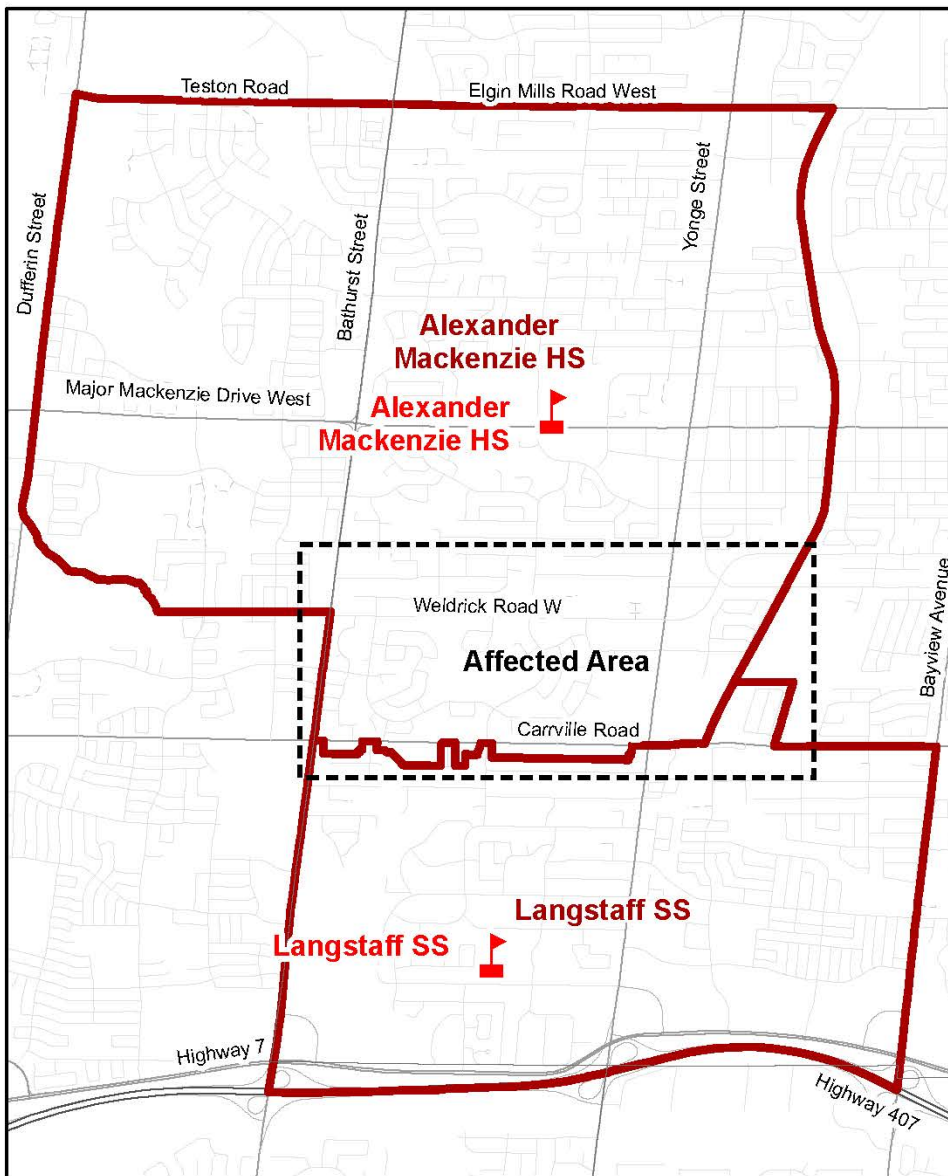

# Existing and Proposed Langstaff Secondary School and Alexander Mackenzie High School Boundaries

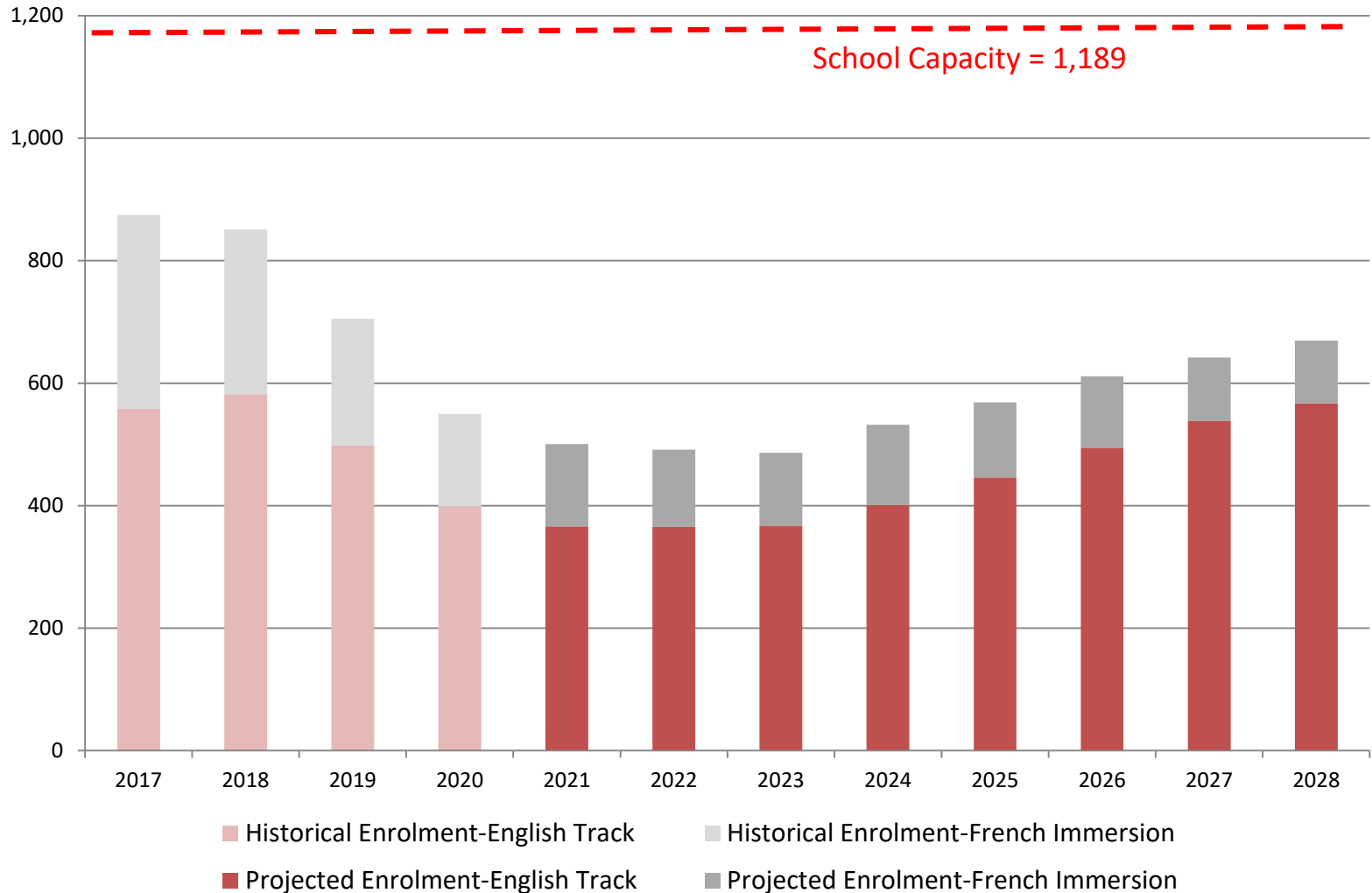


# Timing and Students Impacted

## Langstaff SS

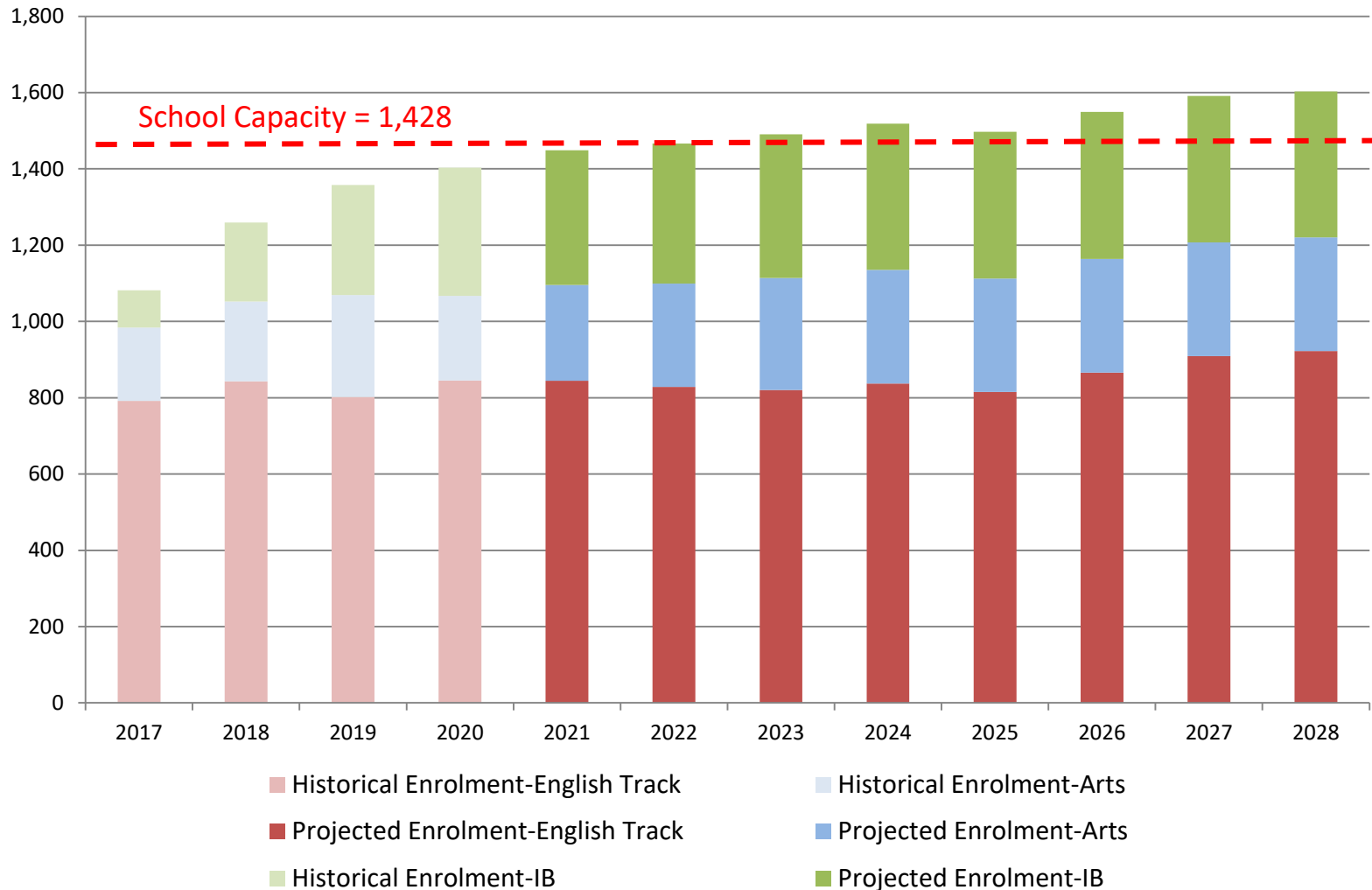


\*Secondary Schools can typically operate above school capacities which are based on an average class size of 23

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# Student Transfers

- Transfers are outlined in [Board Policy 108: Student Accommodation - Attendance Areas and Transfers](#)
  - Schools open/closed to transfers is reviewed on an annual basis
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# Transportation ([Policy 680.0](#))

- Transportation provided as per policy 680
  - Grades 9 to 12 – a secondary school student living in an area served by public transit is not eligible for Board-provided transportation
  - A secondary student living more than 3.2 kilometres from the nearest secondary school in an area not served by public transit is eligible for Board-provided transportation
- School bus transportation eligibility is reviewed annually as York Region Transit (YRT) adjusts and enhances service
