


- The Arts, Health & Physical Education divided between English and French





Lunch Time Rules

- Remain seated in assigned seats
- Keep noise level down by talking quietly to each other.
- Students are not to be running around or engaging in any type of physical play.
- Request to use the washroom.
- Clear eating area of garbage and wipe surface area.
- Use the appropriate receptacles for recyclable items.
- Students are NOT allowed to change rooms at any time.
- Students are supervised by staff on duty while they eat their lunch.
- Students are strongly encouraged to remain at school for lunch and eat in designated areas (ie. classroom)
- Students are to wash hands or use hand sanitizer before and after eating
- Students are to be reminded not to share food, utensils or drink
- Students are not to be using electronic devices (school or personal) unless the classroom teacher is present and supervising.
