# **Cold Weather is Here!**

This is a reminder that all scholars are expected to go outside for recess. Please ensure that your child/ren are dressed appropriately for winter weather. A change of clothes would be helpful for primary children should they get wet during the day. Please make sure all clothing items are labeled with your child's name. Our "Lost and Found" bin gets filled up quickly and belongings often go unclaimed. Please make sure your child has a pair of indoor shoes for school.

Students and families should use extra caution on icy and snow-covered pathways and parking lots. To limit your exposure to foot injury hazards and potential slip and fall injuries:

- When getting in and out of a vehicle, always keep at least one hand on the handle or grab bar so you can catch yourself if you start to slip.
- Scan your pathway for obstructions or slippery conditions
- Use extra caution of icy and snow-covered pathways. Don't hurry when conditions are likely to be slippery.
- Take short steps instead of longer strides.
- Point your feet outward (penguin style).
- Make wide turns rather than sharp turns.
- Do not carry parcels that will obstruct your vision.
- Go around areas that are marked, cordoned off or appear to be dangerous. Do not take shortcuts over snow piles. Always use cleared pathways.
- Keep one hand free so that you can use handrails on stairs including wooden portable stairs.

# **Bus Loop Safety**

Drivers must not park and leave their vehicle in the "Kiss-and-Ride" or Bus Loop as it can be unsafe for arrival and dismissal. The Staff Parking Lot is closed and should not be used.



- ➤ Immediately drop off/pick up passengers
- > NO sitting and waiting for your child
- > NO leaving your vehicle
- > This sign overrides any 'kiss and rides' or any instruction from non-city officials
- ➤ Please drive slowly as you enter the school. Safety is a priority.



# YRDSB Family Dashboard

YRDSB is excited to launch our new **Family Dashboard**. The dashboard will give you secure one-stop access to information and applications related to your child's education. It is designed to make it easier for families to engage with their child's education. In this first phase, the dashboard will include secure access to report cards when they are distributed and links to useful information for parents/guardians.

# Important notes before setting up your account:

- If you wish to use a different email, please contact the school to update your email on file before creating your account. YRDSB email addresses (@yrdsb.ca, @gapps.yrdsb.ca) will not be accepted.
- Each account must have a unique email address, if you have a shared family address that is being used by more than one contact, you will only be able to set up one account. If you would like to set up individual accounts for access, one of the contacts will need to contact the school and update their email address on file with the school.
- As long as your email on file is the same for all your children, when you sign in to the Family Dashboard, you should see all of your children.
- Passwords are required to be a minimum of eight characters and a maximum of 256 characters. Requires three out of four of the following types of characters: lowercase characters; uppercase characters, numbers (0-9); symbols..
- Display Name refers to the parent/guardian who is creating the account. This does not have to match the name in our system.
- If you are not sure of your child's student number, it is your child's student login for Google Classroom.
- You only need information for one student to create your account. Once created, as long as your email on file is the same for all your children, when you sign in to the Family Dashboard, you should see all of your children.
- Once you have set up your account, you can access the dashboard using family.yrdsb.ca
  or under <u>Family Resources</u>, which can be found on the homepage from the Board website or
  school websites.
- If you forget your password from the login screen, select the forgot password in order to create a new password.

# Setting up your account

- Visit family.yrdsb.ca to set up your account.
- Click "No account? Create one" under the email.
- Enter this email address into the email field and click the Next Button.
- Check your email, you will receive an email with a one-time code that expires within 30 minutes in order to confirm your identity.
- Return to the account creation screen and enter this code.
- Once your email has been validated you will be asked to create a password, enter a Display Name (parent/guardian name) and enter the following information about your child or one of your children for further verification:
  - Student Number
  - Student Birthdate
  - Student Home Address Postal Code



# Step to School with Snowball





Winter walking can feel overwhelming, but it doesn't have to be. Below are some important dressing tips and winter walking tips to consider when traveling actively to school. Take some time to review these tips with your child







# Winter Walking Tips

- · Bend knees slightly and keep them loose to give more balance
- · Walk flat footed so more of your foot is touching the ground
- Point your feet out slightly like a penguin
- · Watch where you are stepping
- · Take shorter, shuffle-like steps
- Keep your arms at your sides (not in your pockets!)
- · Concentrate on keeping your balance
- · Very important...walk slowly!

- 腾出一只手,以便可以使用楼梯(包括木制便携式楼梯)上的扶手。

# 设置帐户前的重要说明:

- 如果您希望使用不同的电子邮件,请在创建帐户前联系学校以更新您存档的电子邮件。YRDSB 电子邮件地址((@yrdsb.ca, @gapps.yrdsb.ca) 将不被接受。
- 每个帐户必须有一个唯一的电子邮件地址,如果您有一个共享的家庭地址,并且被多个联系人使用, 您将只能设置一个帐户。如果您想设置个人帐户,其中一个联系人需要联系学校并更新他们在学校存 档的电子邮件地址。
- 只要您存档的电子邮件与您所有孩子的一样,当您登录家庭仪表板时,您应该可以看到所有孩子的姓 名。
