

September Bus Information

For students who qualify, please check the week of August 28th, to verify bus stop locations and times at <u>www.schoolbuscity.com</u>.

If students change their home address, school, grade or caregiver location, they may confirm school bus stop information by accessing <u>www.schoolbuscity.com</u> after August 31st, 2017.

During the first few weeks of school, please ensure students arrive at their bus stop ten minutes early. After this period, it is anticipated that each bus route will develop its regular routine and service times.

Student Transportation Services of York Region provides transportation for students in accordance with the York Region District School Board policy that establishes grade appropriate **Non-Transportation Zone** parameters:

JK to 3 0 – 1.2 km 4 - 8 0 - 1.6 km

Students entering grade 4 and living within 1.6 km from their assigned elementary school, will not be eligible for transportation.

Parents are encouraged to determine their child's eligibility and to make the necessary arrangements should your child no longer qualify for transportation.


