Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration for September 2023 begins January 20 for the 2023-24 school year. Children who were born in 2019, live within the school boundary, and whose parents/guardians are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register for Kindergarten.

There are several ways you can register for Kindergarten:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- **By email** Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration Form</u> at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to school email address aldergrove.ps@yrdsb.ca
- **By phone** Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed, during this phone conversation. Call your local school. (905) 470-2227
- **In-person at the school** Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a registration form.

Once you have completed your application, the school will contact you to make an appointment to review and verify the <u>required documents</u>.

Every Student Count Survey

In the Spring of 2023, YRDSB will be engaging students in Grades K-12 in the <u>Every Student Counts Survey</u>. As was previously communicated, York Region District School Board will be engaging students (Grades K-12) in the <u>Every Student Counts Survey</u> from April 24, 2023 - May 12, 2023 to help us better understand our student population and school communities.

Students in Grades K-3 will complete the survey at home with their parent or guardian. As such, families of students in Grades K-3 who do not wish for their child to fill out the survey do not need to opt-out. Families who do not want their child to fill out the survey can disregard the paper invitation, which will be considered a formal opt-out. Families of students in Grades K-3 who require an accommodation (eg. paper survey in enlarged print) to complete the survey need to contact CCI Research by phone to make a request 1-866-450-4907.

Ramadan Starts on March 23, 2023

Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic calendar and begins on March 23 this year. This is a blessed month for Muslims as it is the month during which the teachings of the Qur'an were revealed. This is considered a time for Muslims to cultivate spiritual renewal through fasting, and an increased focus on prayer and contemplation, as well as a time to recommit themselves to practicing compassion and generosity for others.

Fasting:

Fasting from dawn to sunset during the month of Ramadan is one of the five prescribed tenets of Islamic practice.

Suhoor:

In preparation for each day, most Muslims who are fasting partake in a pre-dawn meal, called Suhoor or Sehri. Muslims are strongly encouraged to partake in this meal in preparation for the day's fast.

Iftar:

The fast concludes at sunset with prayer and a light meal called lftar. The end of the fast is determined by sunset, at which time the Adhan (call to prayer) is recited, and Muslims consume their first food items of the day. These first items are traditionally water and dates. Many masjids (mosques) and community groups will host lftar meals for the public.

Tarawe'eh:

Tarawe'eh prayers are performed only during the month of Ramadhan by some Muslim communities. These prayers take place in congregation following the night prayer. The whole Qur'an is recited over the course of the month during Tarawe'eh prayers.

Students at Aldergrove who are fasting for Ramadan can use the library during lunch time (12:20-12:40). The Quiet Space Room (Room (119) may be used for prayers during the day.

The International Day of Pink

April 12, 2023 is the International Day of Pink. The International Day of Pink is a day when

communities across Canada and across the world unite to celebrate diversity and raise awareness about the need to stop homophobia, transphobia, discrimination and all forms of bullying. On this annual day in April, individuals wear pink to show respect for diversity and to demonstrate support for learning and working environments which are safe and inclusive of people from all different backgrounds. International Day of Pink is intended to create a more inclusive and diverse world. The Day of Pink originated in Eastern Canada, after a few young students decided to stand up against homophobia, bullying and toxic masculinity. Although the first Day of Pink occurred 16 years ago, students continue to experience homophobia.

World Autism Acceptance Month

We work together to create spaces for all our learners including our neurodiverse learners. April is Autism Acceptance Month. April 2 is World Autism Day. This year we are moving from raising

awareness for Autism to increasing acceptance. Acceptance and awareness come from vastly different mindsets. Awareness seeks to highlight how Other we are and emphasizes the differences and distance between our ways of being. Acceptance looks at commonalities we share and at the strength inherent in diversity. Some students self-identify as an Autistic person as part of their social identity. At the YRDSB, the way we recognize World Autism Acceptance Month is through consultation with our students with autism, their families and using our professional judgement.



The most important thing to remember is that when you're talking about autism, you're talking about a person.




Skilled Trades Ontario



每个学生都很重要调查

2023 年春季,YRDSB 将让 K-12 年级的学生参与"<u>每个学生都很重要调查</u>"。 正如之前所传达的那样,约克地区教育局将于 2023 年 4 月 24 日至 2023 年 5 月 12 日让学生(K-12 年级)参与<u>每个学生都很</u>重要调查,以帮助我们更好地了解我们的学生和学校社区。

斋月于 2023 年 3 月 23 日开始

斋月是伊斯兰历的第九个月,从今年的3月23日开始。 对于穆斯林来说,这是一个蒙福的月份,因为它是古兰经教义被揭示的月份。 这被认为是穆斯林通过禁食培养精神更新的时刻,更加注重祈祷和沉思,以及重新致力于为他人实践同情和慷慨的时刻。

禁食:

在斋月期间从黎明到日落禁食是伊斯兰教习俗的五项规定原则之一。

Suhoor:

在为每一天做准备时,大多数禁食的穆斯林都会参加黎明前的一顿饭,称为 Suhoor 或 Sehri。 强烈鼓励穆斯林参加这顿饭,为当天的斋戒做准备。

开斋饭:

禁食在日落时以祈祷和一顿名为开斋饭的便餐结束。 斋戒的结束由日落决定,此时宣读宣礼(祈祷),穆斯林食用他们当天的第一批食物。 这些第一批物品传统上是水和枣子。 许多清真寺(清真寺)和社区团体将为公众举办开斋饭。

Tarawe' eh:

一些穆斯林社区仅在斋月期间进行 Tarawe'eh 祈祷。 这些祈祷在夜间祈祷后在会众中进行。 在 Tarawe'eh 祈祷期间,整个月都会背诵整本古兰经。

Aldergrove 的斋月斋戒学生可以在午餐时间(12:20-12:40)使用图书馆。 安静空间室(房间(119))可在白天用于祈祷。

国际粉红日

2023 年 4 月 12 日是国际粉红日。 在国际粉红日这一天,加拿大和世界各地的社区团结起来庆祝多样性,并提高人们对停止恐同、跨性别、歧视和各种形式欺凌的必要性的认识。 在每年四月的这一天,人们穿上粉红色衣服以表示对多样性的尊重,并表明对安全且包容来自不同背景的人的学习和工作环境的支持。 国际粉红日旨在创造一个更具包容性和多样性的世界。 粉红日起源于加拿大东部,当时一些年轻学生决定站出来反对同性恋恐惧症,欺凌和有毒的男性气质。 尽管第一个"粉红日"发生在 16 年前,但学生们仍在经历同性恋恐惧症、跨性别恐惧症和双性恋恐惧症。 学校和工作场所需要致力于为 2SLGBTQ+ 社区的学生提高认识、建立包容和消除歧视。
