Ramadan, March 10 - April 10, 2024

Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic calendar and begins on March 10 this year. This is a blessed month for Muslims as it is the month during which the teachings of the Qur'an were revealed. This is considered a time for Muslims to cultivate spiritual renewal through fasting, and an increased focus on prayer and contemplation, as well as a time to recommit themselves to practicing compassion and generosity for others.

Fasting:

Fasting from dawn to sunset during the month of Ramadan is one of the five prescribed tenets of Islamic practice.

Suhoor:

In preparation for each day, most Muslims who are fasting partake in a pre-dawn meal, called Suhoor or Sehri. Muslims are strongly encouraged to partake in this meal in preparation for the day's fast.

Iftar:

The fast concludes at sunset with prayer and a light meal called lftar. The end of the fast is determined by sunset, at which time the Adhan (call to prayer) is recited, and Muslims consume their first food items of the day. These first items are traditionally water and dates. Many masjids (mosques) and community groups will host lftar meals for the public.

Tarawe'eh:

Tarawe'eh prayers are performed only during the month of Ramadhan by some Muslim communities. These prayers take place in congregation following the night prayer. The whole Qur'an is recited over the course of the month during Tarawe'eh prayers.

Students at Aldergrove who are fasting for Ramadan can use the library during lunch time (12:20-12:40). The Quiet Space Room (Room (119) may be used for prayers during the day.

Transgender Day of Visibility

March 31 is the International Transgender Day of Visibility. Trans Day of Visibility is an annual awareness day celebrated around the world. The day is dedicated to celebrating the accomplishments of transgender and gender nonconforming people while raising awareness of the work that still needs to be done to achieve trans justice.

Right now, members of school communities can take these actions to help create trans-inclusive school environments.



World Autism Acceptance Month

We work together to create spaces for all our learners including our neurodiverse learners. April is Autism Acceptance Month. April 2 is World Autism Day. This year we are moving from raising awareness for Autism to increasing acceptance.

Acceptance and awareness come from vastly different mindsets. Awareness seeks to highlight how Other we are and emphasizes the differences and distance between our ways of being. Acceptance looks at commonalities we share and at the strength inherent in diversity. Some students self-identify as an Autistic person as part of their social identity. At the YRDSB,

the way we recognize World Autism Acceptance Month is through consultation with our students with autism, their families and using our professional judgement.



The most important thing to remember is that when you're talking about autism, you're talking about a person.

The International Day of Pink

April 10, 2024 is the International Day of Pink. The International Day of Pink is a day when

communities across Canada and across the world unite to celebrate diversity and raise awareness about the need to stop homophobia, transphobia, discrimination and all forms of bullying. On this annual day in April, individuals wear pink to show respect for diversity and to demonstrate support for learning and working environments which are safe and inclusive of people from all different backgrounds. International Day of Pink is intended to create a more inclusive and diverse world. The Day of Pink originated in Eastern Canada, after a few young students decided to stand up against homophobia, bullying and toxic masculinity. Although the first Day of Pink occurred 17 years ago, students continue to experience homophobia, transphobia and biphobia. Schools and workplaces need to



commit to raising awareness, building inclusion and eliminating discrimination for students in 2SLGBTQ+ communities.

Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration for September 2024 begins January 19 for the 2024-25 school year. Children who turn four or five years old during 2024, live within the school boundary, and whose parents/guardians are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register for Kindergarten. There are several ways you can register for Kindergarten:

- Online Families can access the online Kindergarten registration information at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/kindergarten</u>. It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School Registration Form</u> at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address. Email addresses can be found on the school website.
- By phone Families can request support to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. Families can request an interpreter, if needed, during this phone conversation. <u>Call your local school</u>.
- In-person at the school Families may visit the school office to drop off or complete a registration form.

Once you have completed your application, the school will contact you to make an appointment to review and verify the <u>required documents</u>.


#Storytelling - Snuggle up in a cozy spot at home and get ready to relax and enjoy a story.
