First Day Routines for Scholars - Tuesday, September 5, 2023

You should have already received your child's homeroom code (e.g. GR1-1 or GR6-2) in a separate communication.

What time should my child arrive at school?

Students should arrive at the school by 8:15 a.m. in the morning. Teachers will be present outside, in the school yard.

Where do students go to meet their classroom teacher on the first day of school?

Grades 1-8: On the first day of school, please proceed to back tarmac. Find the class code posted on the back window or portable.

FDK: Please take your child to the kindergarten area. You would have already received a separate communication regarding drop off and pick up areas.

If you do not receive your child's homeroom code for any reason, please arrive at the back of the school on September 5th at 8:15am and staff will be able to direct you where to go.

Where do I pick my child up at the end of the day?

Please meet your child where you dropped them off in the morning at 3pm. The school parking lot will not be available at the end of the day. There is street parking available on the side streets.

What will happen in the event of bad weather?

If it rains on Tuesday morning, Grades 1-6 scholars will go directly to their hallway. Our Grade 7-8 scholars will go to the upstairs hallway. Our K scholars will go straight to their classrooms. There will be staff wearing duty vests to help. Thank you parents for remaining outside and saying your goodbyes at the doors.
