All schools in the York Region District School Board are committed to improving student achievement and well-being. On **Thursday, June 30, 2022,** an early release day will take place to allow elementary teachers and support staff to take part in meetings during the afternoon of that day. A final reminder - please do not park in the staff parking lot at the end of the day as there have been some serious child safety incidents as parents exit out of the lot. Families are asked to either park in designated areas on the street or follow pick up directions from staff in the bus loop.



Our **Eco Club** wants to encourage families to think more about how much waste we produce daily. For the month of June, all items that normally go in the garbage will instead be returned home in students' lunch boxes. This initiative is called Boomerang Lunches. It is our hope that families will look at the waste coming home and think of alternative ways to pack

lunches, such as putting items in reusable containers. *For sanitization reasons, masks will still be permitted in the garbage, but students are reminded to cut or tear off the ear loops so they do not harm our animal friends.

Kindergarten Registration

Kindergarten registration for September 2022 began January 14 for the 2022-23 school year. Children who were born in 2018, live within the school boundary and whose parents/guardians are public school tax supporters will be eligible to register for Kindergarten.

There are several ways you can register for Kindergarten:

 It is recommended that families use a laptop or a desktop, rather than a mobile device to complete this registration.
- By email Families can download the <u>Elementary School</u> Registration Form at <u>www.yrdsb.ca/Kindergarten</u> and email the completed form to their school email address Aldergrove.ps@yrdsb.ca.

- **By phone** Families can request support from the school office to complete the registration form on their behalf by collecting the required information by phone. School contact number (905) 470-2227
- **By mail or appointment.** You can mail completed applications to the school, or request an appointment to drop-off your completed paper application form. Families are asked to follow all school COVID-19 protocols while on site. All permitted visitors must wear a mask.

Please note, at this time, under our <u>health and safety protocols</u>, we cannot accept walk-in registrations. Once you have completed your application, the school will contact you to make an appointment to review and verify the <u>required documents</u>.

- 25 years of Black Youth Helpline (BYH) experience has proved informing. We must Intervene on behalf of youth with complex needs before severe problems arise.
- Needed are primary prevention approaches including a focus on parents and schools at the earliest possible point.
- A significant body of literature underline that suspensions and dismissals from schools are 3-4 times higher for vulnerable children.
- The word "drop-out" is often a misnomer.
 Repeated suspensions and dismissals fuel school failure and push students out of schools (Wilson, 2014). "We need to comprehend fully why schools fail some youths and conversely, why some students are failing school" (Dei, 1996).
- By helping youth, parents and schools succeed we increase the chances for productive futures for Canada's children


