- Instrumental music begins in Grade 9 and continues through to Grade 12.

- Grade 9 Instrumental Music students can choose between beginner band (AMI1O2) and advanced band (AMI1O1). Any student planning to continue on the same instrument they played in Grade 8 should choose advanced band.
