

### Dear Parents/Guardians:

Hope you are doing well. In this newsletter, you will find some relevant information and updates about our IB program at AMHS.

Many IB students participated in the <a href="Physics Bowl">Physics Bowl</a> Contest on March 25th. They had 45 minutes to answer 40 Multiple Choice questions in Physics with increasing difficulty. Results for the contest will be available soon.





We used to run the Sir Issac Newton (SIN) Physics contest by the University of Waterloo in the past, however, it usually coincided with the IB exam time so we did not run it for a few years. Physics bowl is organized by the American Association of Physics Teachers (AAPT).

**Starting Gr. 11 (DP1),** teachers in IB classes will use IB materials in teaching and in assessment. Although there are similarities between IB materials and Ontario curriculum, students in all courses are learning so much more in such a short time. As a result, IB schools in Ontario have a mark alignment mechanism to align marks based on the intensity of the program. The mark alignment for **DP1 and DP2** is based on IB students' performance over the years statistically and every subject has a slightly different alignment table. You can always ask your child's IB subject teacher to share the corresponding alignment chart with you.

After DP1 and DP2 students write the IB exams in May, the overall IB results will be available in July. Each IB level corresponds to a specific range of mark percentage. For example, level 6 corresponds to anywhere from 93 to 96 as the final mark. Once the IB exam results become available in July, based on the marks on the June report card, we will use this alignment chart to readjust the final mark for each course. Changes will be made in September in the following school year.

**Exam schedule -** Below is the exam schedule for DP1 and DP2 students. As mentioned before, we are not able to accommodate any request for moving the exam to any other date or time. Failure to write exams may result in losing the IB Diploma that your child has been working hard on.
