## **CAS requirement:**

CAS stands for Creativity, Activity and Service (<u>reference</u>). It is one of the core and required components in the IB programme. Without completing the CAS requirements, the IB Diploma can not be awarded. Starting in Gr. 11, we have a team of teachers working together to support students to fulfill the CAS requirements. We also have a CAS coordinator who oversees the CAS process for our students. Just a reminder that the activities done in the summer after the Grade 10 year **cannot** be counted towards CAS. All CAS activities can be counted only after the Diploma Program has started.

- Complete translations
- Create images on request
- Writes computer code on request and much more.

As you probably know, the IB does not believe that AI tools should be banned in education. IB has published a lot of information about how to handle AI properly and there are guidelines for teachers and students. These guidelines have been shared with our teaching staff.
