Here is a question that comes up frequently: What is International Baccalaureate (IB) program?

The International Baccalaureate (IB) program is like a global (international) schooling system that's aimed at developing well-rounded students who can think critically, understand different cultures, and contribute to the world in a positive way. The IB Program doesn't just give students knowledge, but also tools like critical thinking, research skills, and a global perspective to use that knowledge effectively.

Gr. 9 and 10: Pre-IB program


Students take most of the classes with other Gr. 9 and 10 Pre-IB students.

Each student will have 4 courses in each semester.

Courses are based on the Ontario curriculum with additional mark alignments with the IB assessment standards and practices. The pre-IB program infuses elements of the IB Learner Profile while preparing students for success in curriculum subjects and core diploma elements such as Creativity Activity Service, Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge in the grade 11 and 12 years.

Gr. 11 and 12: Diploma Program (DP)

Grade 11 is when the Core IB Diploma Program (DP) starts. Over the course of the two-year IB Diploma Programme, students study six subjects chosen from the six subject groups (3 in Higher Level, 3 in Standard Level), complete an Extended Essay, follow a theory of knowledge (TOK) course, and participate in creativity, activity, service (CAS).
