What about the IB program at AMHS?

At AMHS, we are licensed to provide the Diploma Program (DP) in Gr. 11 and 12. So formally, the IB DP will start in the Gr. 11 year for your child. Gr. 9 and 10 are called the Preparatory Years in which students are going to take many IB streamed courses. These courses are very similar to the courses in our regular program, with enhancements in contents and focusing on building capacity for them to transition into the Diploma Program.

One of the main goals in our IB program is providing opportunities for students to build resiliencies and capacities to meet various challenges in the future.
