Ascending Sisters+ serves as a mentorship program that connects Black girls and nonbinary students in grades 7 to 10 with Black YRDSB staff in alignment with the YRDSB Dismantling Anti-Black Racism Strategy. Programming will include: leadership training, career exploration, guest speakers, connections to affirming community initiatives, connections to healing and wellbeing activities.

- Priorities of the program :
- An affirming space where we can learn more about our shared history and identity.
 An opportunity to build a collective voice for Black girls
- Build self confidence and self-esteem for students to be their best selves and future leaders.
- Developing knowledge of post-secondary education and potential career pathways, strengthening communication and advocacy skills.
- Learning strategies that support one's mental health and provide wellness.
