Guidance Services

Teaching our children how to use technology safely and appropriately is a challenge we all face. I wanted to share with you that Facebook has a Facebook Parents Portal, which features various resources for parents. According to Facebook, this portal is aimed at assisting conversations between parents and their children about staying safe online. Psychologists recommend two key items for parents when it comes to using technology:

1. Have lots of conversations with kids about what they're doing online and how to be safe. If this is a normal part of daily discussion, and something difficult comes up, your child will be more willing to share or ask for help.

2. Have guidelines in place as a family. These can address screen time, online content, and rules about sharing access to all social media accounts.

Upcoming EQAO Math Assessments

In January 2020, Grade 9 students across Ontario will write the provincial Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics. This assessment is conducted by the Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO), an independent agency of the Government of Ontario. It will be administered to all students enrolled in a Grade 9 Applied or Academic Mathematics course in Semester One, and the results of this assessment will comprise 5% of each student's final mark in their Math course.

At Alexander Mackenzie High School, this assessment will be written by students on Wednesday, January 15 and Thursday, January 16, 2020. The assessment will consist of two test booklets, and students will be given 60 minutes to complete each booklet over the course of two days, during regularly scheduled Math periods.

In September 2020, EQAO will send our school a report on your child's achievement on the assessment, and we will send it home at that time.

This year's Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT) is being written on Tuesday, March 31, 2020. The test is written by all eligible students in Grade 10, who started high school in September of 2018. Successful completion of the OSSLT is a requirement all students must meet in order to graduate.

Our school is preparing students for this important assessment in a variety of ways. Stay tuned for updates as preparation opportunities become available to support test-writers, as the test date approaches.

Parking and Ticketing

Ticketing at AMHS began on Tuesday, September 3rd. All students and visitors are required to display a valid parking permit in their vehicle at all times in order to park on school property.
