Guidance Services

A significant number of college and university admission teams are using supplementary applications as a tool to give them a more holistic view of an applicant. While academic performance is important, post-secondary institutions are looking for well-rounded students who can also demonstrate leadership potential, teamwork experience, resilience, and empathy towards others. The Guidance Department at AMHS is committed in supporting students in their supplementary application writing process. Thus, our Lunch-n-Learn session on Monday, December 9 will focus specifically on helping students with creating a successful supplementary application. In addition, we also urge students to seek support from their parents and/or caring adults who can help them navigate application considerations.

The supplementary application deadlines vary from school to school, and we encourage students to set-up and check the university portals of their choice for more up-to-date information, once they apply through the Ontario Application Centre (OUAC).

Upcoming EQAO Math Assessments

In January 2020, Grade 9 students across Ontario will write the provincial Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics. This assessment is conducted by the Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO), an independent agency of the Government of Ontario. It will be administered to all students enrolled in a Grade 9 Applied or Academic Mathematics course in Semester One, and the results of this assessment will comprise 5% of each student's final mark in their Math course.

At Alexander Mackenzie High School, this assessment will be written by students on Wednesday, January 15 and Thursday, January 16, 2020. The assessment will consist of two test booklets, and students will be given 60 minutes to complete each booklet over the course of two days, during regularly scheduled Math periods.

In September 2020, EQAO will send our school a report on your child's achievement on the assessment, and we will send it home at that time.

Parking and Ticketing

Ticketing at AMHS began on Tuesday, September 3rd. All students and visitors are required to display a valid parking permit in their vehicle at all times in order to park on school property.
