Changes to AMHS School Day For September 2020

Alexander Mackenzie High School enrolment has been steadily growing since 2016 and is projected to continue to grow. Beginning in September 2020, adjustments to the school timetable will need to be made to accommodate increasing student enrolment.

Currently, Alexander Mackenzie High School operates with four (4) periods of instruction and a common lunch. Beginning September 2020, the bell times for Alexander Mackenzie High School will need to be adjusted to support five (5) periods of instruction, along with multiple lunch breaks. This modification will increase the capability of the school to accommodate more students.

The new bell times will shift the morning bell time to 10 minutes earlier, and the afternoon bell time to 15 minutes later. This model of the instructional day is common across York Region District School Board secondary schools. The chart above outlines the new start and end times of periods, which will go into effect beginning in September 2020.

Guidance Services

This week, our students began the process of selecting their courses for the next academic year through a program called myBlueprint.

As a reminder, <u>course selection submission occurs from February 12- February 24</u>. Once your child has submitted their courses electronically, they are still required to do a printout of their submission, obtain your signature, and hand in their form to their homeroom teacher. <u>Course selection closes on Monday,</u> <u>February 24</u>. As we point students in the direction of their future, we also need them to focus on the present. Taking time to slow down and not stress about what the future holds is essential for well-being. During the two weeks of course selection, we particularly like to connect with students for individual appointments to help them evaluate their priorities and set future academic/post-secondary goals. During these individual appointments we, as guidance counsellors, ask students to reflect on the following questions: "What do you like?" (passion), "What do you think the world needs?" (challenges), and "What are you good at?" (strength). We urge students to try new courses in order to gain new experiences and new skills. Teaching through experiences is where we see growth for young people. Thus, we encourage students to try a dual credit courses, and/or cooperative education course and to join one our four Specialist High Skills Majors (Business, Health and Wellness, Arts and Culture, Transportation) available at AMHS.

Parking and Ticketing

Ticketing at AMHS began on Tuesday, September 3rd. All students and visitors are required to display a valid parking permit in their vehicle at all times in order to park on school property. Any vehicle parked on AMHS property without a valid parking permit will be subject to ticketing.
