Semester One Report Cards

Semester One Report Cards will be distributed in homeroom classes (Period 1) on Monday, February 10, 2020. Please remind your child to share their report card with you on that day.

Please be aware that as a result of the Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation work-to-rule strike sanction, secondary teachers are inputting student report card marks electronically, but are not writing comments. As such, this Semester One Final Report Card will continue to be provided for secondary students with marks, but no comments. Grade 12 students' marks will be submitted to the Ontario College Application Service (OCAS) and to the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) on time so that students' post-secondary applications will not be affected.

While only marks are available on Semester One Final Report Cards, teachers' assessment and evaluation of student work has continued to occur. Teachers will continue to communicate with students regarding feedback on their work. If you have any questions regarding your child's marks or learning progress, please contact the appropriate teacher.

Changes to AMHS School Day For September 2020

Alexander Mackenzie High School enrolment has been steadily growing since 2016 and is projected to continue to grow. Beginning in September 2020, adjustments to the school timetable will need to be made to accommodate increasing student enrolment.

Currently, Alexander Mackenzie High School operates with four (4) periods of instruction and a common lunch. Beginning September 2020, the bell times for Alexander Mackenzie High School will need to be adjusted to support five (5) periods of instruction, along with multiple lunch breaks. This modification will increase the capability of the school to accommodate more students.

The new bell times will shift the morning bell time to 10 minutes earlier, and the afternoon bell time to 15 minutes later. This model of the instructional day is common across York Region District School Board secondary schools. The chart below outlines the new start and end times of periods, which will go into effect beginning in September 2020.

Guidance Services

We've had a great start to Semester Two here at Alexander Mackenzie HS. This week was a busy time in Guidance. Some of our students engaged in the process of requesting timetable changes for varied reasons. As always, we ask for your patience with our process as we ensure that we provide equitable and timely service for all of our students.

Our students will begin their course selection for next year on Monday. This year once again we will be using our course selection tool, called myBlueprint. All students will be called down to the library over the next two weeks for the working sessions. We welcome conversations about pathways with your child at any time, but we particularly encourage these conversations during the course selection time. Guidance is available to answer questions and help in this process with appointments starting next week. As a reminder, <u>course selection opens on-line on Wednesday, February 12</u> for students to begin submitting their courses. Once your child has submitted his/her courses electronically, they are still required to do a printout of their submission, obtain your signature and hand in their form to their homeroom teacher. <u>Course selection closes on Monday, February 24</u>.

The Equal Consideration Deadline for applying to Ontario Universities was Wednesday, January 17. The College application deadline for equal consideration was on February 1st. Students can still apply but their application may not receive first consideration amongst applicants.

Parking and Ticketing

Ticketing at AMHS began on Tuesday, September 3rd. All students and visitors are required to display a valid parking permit in their vehicle at all times in order to park on school property.
