Grad Updates

- All Graduates will receive 2 guest tickets to the Graduation Ceremony on Wednesday, June 26th, 2024. Graduates do not require a ticket. If you would like to submit a request for an additional ticket please complete the Google form that will be sent out on June 3rd at 8:00am. Extra tickets will be distributed on a first come, first serve basis. Those who are successful in their extra ticket request will receive a separate notification to pay the \$20 fee for the extra ticket through School Cash Online on June 5th by June 10th. The Google form is the only way to request the purchase of an additional ticket.
- Many graduates have yet to submit their volunteer hours. This is a requirement for graduation. Students must complete 40 hours. Please speak to your student to find out if this is complete, and if not, please encourage them to do so soon (March break is a great opportunity).
