The spirit activities will only be available during the common lunch (11:45 - 1:00 p.m.).

To ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all, remember:

1. Students are not permitted to wear costumes that devalue and/or trivialize the lives of Indigenous peoples in Canada.

2. Costumes must be respectful of others. Symbols or objects representative of a person's race, culture, ethnicity, or religious beliefs, should not be worn as another person's costume, nor should costumes that caricature social identities through stereotyping.

3. **Students choosing to celebrate the 31st/Spooky Fall Fest in costume** at school must comply with the York Region District School Board's Safe, Caring and Supportive Schools Policy #668.0. Therefore, **students are reminded that their costumes** <u>MUST NOT</u> under any circumstances include weapons or replica weapons (toy guns, knives, axes, swords, etc.) of any kind.

4. No Halloween MASKS are to be worn.

5. Students should only use single use make-up (sharing of make-up is not recommended).
