# **Parking and Ticketing**

Ticketing at AMHS began on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. All students and visitors will be required to display a valid parking permit in their vehicle at all times in order to park on school property. Any vehicle parked on AMHS property without a valid parking permit will be subject to ticketing. It is your responsibility to ensure that a valid parking permit is clearly visible to our parking enforcement officers. Be sure to request a parking pass when you sign in at the main office, all visitors to the school must report to main office. Parking is on a first come first served basis, availability can not be guaranteed.
