
#### Library Learning Commons

The Mathematics Department is committed to support the academic success of all students in accordance with the Ministry guidelines and board policies. The hybrid program is being delivered according to the schedule set by the school. We believe in the value of communication and welcome the input of parents and guardians. On behalf of the Mathematics Council, I am writing to give you some updates. There are currently about 35 students involved in the Mathematics Council, and the number of members



will continue to grow as reflected by the pattern of the previous years. The executives are fully engaged. All the meetings and events will be conducted online for this academic year. In addition, council members are working diligently in setting up webinar sessions to facilitate the preparation for the upcoming Math contests. Canadian Open Math Challenge (COMC 2020): 37 students have registered. The contest is scheduled

to take place on Thursday October 29, 2020 at 12 noon. Students will write the contest on-line remotely.

University of Waterloo Canadian Intermediate Math Contest (for Grade 9 and 10) and Canadian Senior Math Contest (for Grade 11 and 12): The contests are scheduled to take place on Wednesday, November 18, 2020. These are online contests, and students will take the contests remotely.

Registration for the above contests will be available on School Cash Online from Thursday, October 15 to Wednesday, October 28, 2020. **The registration deadline is Wednesday**, **October 28, 2020**.


