### Don't rush your brush!

- · Brush twice a day for two minutes, especially before bedtime
- · Rinse your mouth with water after meals and snacks to reduce acid and remove food debris
- · Wait 30 minutes after meals/snacks/beverages before brushing
- Brush gently
- · Use fluoridated toothpaste
- Children under three years of age or who cannot spit should only use water or a rice grain-sized
  amount of non-fluoridated toothpaste unless otherwise advised by their oral health professional

### Tips for flossing

- · Floss daily
- · Floss before brushing
