Semester 2 Final Assessments - June 19th to June 26th.

As of the 2022-23 school year, the Ministry of Education requires we resume the policy on final evaluations. For Grades 9 to 12, a final grade (percentage mark) is recorded for every course. Final grades will be determined as follows: Seventy percent of the grade will be based on evaluation conducted throughout the course and thirty percent of the grade will be based on a final evaluation administered at or towards the end of the course. This evaluation will be based on evidence from one or a combination of the following: an examination, a performance, an essay, and/or another method of evaluation suitable to the course content. The final evaluation allows the student an opportunity to demonstrate comprehensive achievement of the overall expectations for the course. Students are expected to be present for their final evaluation as such this is not a good time for absences for family vacations. Please plan accordingly.
