It saddens me to say that yesterday our school was tagged with Anti-Semitic graffiti that you may have seen. We are deeply saddened by the racist graffiti and are aware of the impact that it will have on our school community. In the York Region District School Board, we value the Well-Being and inclusion of all of our students and their families and consider this a serious incident that is disrespectful to members of our school community. We believe, behaviour that is not addressed becomes accepted behaviour and thus, we are taking this situation very seriously and have begun an investigation with the York Regional Police to ensure that it is being dealt with appropriately. Actions such as this do not represent the values of our school community. This is our building and we all have a responsibility to ensure it represents our values and beliefs. If anyone has any information about this incident, please take responsibility and share this with a teacher or the main office. Thank you.
