NEW INFORMATION AND UPDATES

School Photos: York Region Public Health is now allowing individual student photographs (no class/group photos). We have secured the date of Monday, November 22nd for our photos. At this time, we are awaiting further information regarding options for our remote learners.

Hallowe'en: When preparing your child/ren for Halloween at school, please note that costumes should be respectful of others. Symbols or objects representative of a person's culture or religious beliefs, should not be worn as another person's costume, nor should costumes that caricature social identities through stereotyping. Be sensitive to images and media use. No Halloween masks are to be worn and students should only use single use make-up (no sharing of make-up). Please limit personal items being brought to school, costumes should be of simple design. No replica weapons of any kind are allowed. Due to COVID protocols, we will not be able to have our traditional Halloween parade, nor will students be able to access the washrooms or change rooms to change their costumes. We would ask that any costumes sent to school are simple in nature as the students will need to remain in them for the day. Additional information regarding our Halloween celebrations will be shared by teachers next week.
