

The <u>afternoon</u> Spring Concert will begin at 2:25pm. The doors will be opening at 2:10pm for families to enter the gym. If you are attending the afternoon performances please know parking is limited. Please do not park in the school parking lot. Park on Yakefarm Blvd or surrounding streets.

Following the performance families will be able to pick their child(ren) following normal dismissal routines. Please pick up your child from the kindergarten gates.

The **evening** Spring Concert will begin at 6pm. The doors will be opening at 5:45pm for families to enter the gym. Please drop your child off at the kindergarten gates for the evening performance. You can drop them off between 5:30 pm and 5:40 pm; this will give them time to get ready for their performance. This will also make it easier for the educators to see who has come back for the evening performance.

In order to maintain safe dismissal policies and support the routines that are already in place we will be following our normal dismissal protocol. Please pick your child up from their kindergarten gate following the conclusion of the evening performance.
