Family/Educator Interviews: This is a reminder that you may now sign up for Family/Educator Interviews on the Edsby platform. Please login to yrdsb.edsby.com to go to your parent Edsby account to schedule your appointment. Interviews will take place the evening of Thursday, November 17 (4:00-8:00) and the morning of Friday, November 18 (9:00-12:00) for students in Kindergarten Year 2 (previously known as Senior Kindergarten) through Grade 8. This also means that Friday, November 18 is a P.A. Day. There is no instruction for students on this day, though they are welcome to join you when you come in for your interview. Registration for interviews will close at 4:00 on the afternoon of Wednesday, November 16. Information regarding observation visits for students in Kindergarten Year 1 (previously known as Junior Kindergarten) was sent home to families from their child's educators earlier this week. Families are asked to return forms to their child's educators by Monday, November 14.

Progress Reports: Progress Reports will be available digitally the week of November 21-25. You will need your child's GAPPs account information in order to access the file. A paper copy will be sent home next week prior to the Family/Educator Interview date.

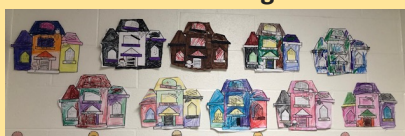

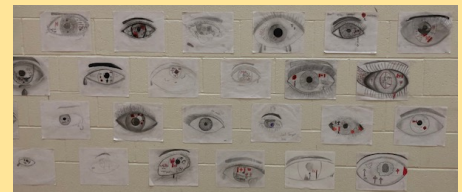
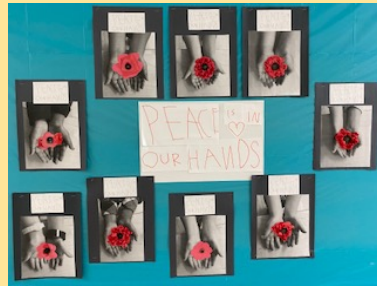
