Keeping Us All Safe As School Re-Opens

- * Families should be using the ***updated (Feb 25)
 Screening Tool each day (see attachment)
- * With just <u>one</u> symptom, the individual (and <u>all</u> family members) are required to stay home
- * Masks are required for all students (Grades 1-8)
- * Masks are recommended for Kindergarten students
- * 3-layer masks are recommended (2-layer will be permitted if they are clean and fit appropriately)
- * Anyone coming onto school property (including families during pick-up and drop-off) are required to wear a mask and maintain 2m distance from others
- * Students and families are asked to not congregate before and after school. All adults MUST wear masks on school property at all times.

<u>Message from BRPS:</u> Thank you to the entire BRPS community for all of the incredible support! We hope that everyone has a safe and restful Spring Break. Please remember to follow Public Health regulations (including those families currently in self-isolation) and the Provincial stay-at-home order.
