Student pick-up/drop-off: We all continue to work to keep students, community members, and staff safe during this pandemic. Following direction provided by Public Health will continue to be of importance. We need to remind everyone that only one adult should be picking up students and we are asking all adults to wear masks while doing so. Reducing the number of people on the area outside of the Kindergarten pen and the back tarmac will help keep everyone safer. Please remember physical distancing protocols on the tarmac. There are black lines on the sidewalk outside the Kindergarten fence that are 2m+ apart. Thank you for your support in this regard.

<u>Electronic Report Card Distribution:</u> YRDSB will be distributing Progress Reports electronically on November 20. Instructions will be provided to families on November 16th. The Progress Report will be sent to your child's GAPPS account and families will be notified by email when it is available.

Recess Protocols: Our new recess protocol is in effect this week. All cohorts of students are well below 50 in each area during recess and lunch time. The West tarmac is now closed during these times and we are using the 3 large painted zones on our tarmac and field. In each Zone there will be less than 50 students. Students will either come outside for morning recess from 10:50-11:05, or from 11:05-11:20. At lunchtime, rather than having everyone eat from 1:00-1:20, Cohort A (Zones 1, 2 & 3) is outside for recess from 1:00-1:30, while Cohort B (Zones 1, 2 & 3) is inside eating and getting ready to go outside. From 1:30-2:00, the students switch places and Cohort B (Zones 1, 2 & 3) is outside for recess and Cohort A (Zones 1, 2 & 3). We will continue to monitor our protocols and follow direction from Public Health and our Board.
