All adults MUST wear masks on school property at all times.

<u>Kiss 'n Ride:</u> Reminder to parents - only Kindergarten student pick-up between 3:25 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. To pick-up students in Grades 1-8, please wait until 3:40 p.m. During drop-off in the morning, please ensure that your child does not get out of the vehicle unless you are in a parking spot or pulled over directly against the Kiss 'n Ride curb. We have had too many children getting out of vehicles by the corner at the end of the Kiss 'n Ride and not against the curb. This creates an extremely dangerous situation and also causes unnecessary congestion. Please wait for a spot against the curb or find a parking spot. Thank you for your help in ensuring everyone's safety.

<u>Student Loaner Technology:</u> For families who borrowed a Chromebook to support remote learning, please return this equipment to the school, including all power adapters. The equipment should be placed in a plastic bag with the students name on it. Students started returning these devices on February 16th. They will checked and sanitized and returned to in-school rotation.
