IB Diploma Programme Course of Study



Over the course of a two year programme:

Six academic subjects
 from six subject groups



IB Course Terminology

HL (Higher Level) course = 3 semesters of course work

SL (Standard Level) courses = 2 semesters of course work





Students take:

- 3 subjects at the **HL** level
- 3 subjects at the SL Level

Complete the IB Core:

- Extended Essay
- Theory of Knowledge
- Creativity, Activity and Service





Bayview's Course of Study

IB Core - Extended Essay

Extended Essay 4,000 word investigation of a topic of special interest outside of the regular curriculum





IB Core - Theory of Knowledge

Challenges students to question the basis of knowledge, to develop the ability to analyze evidence and to appreciate other cultural perspectives







Creativity, Activity, Service



- Students engage in a range of enjoyable & significant experiences that foster growth in areas of Creativity, Activity and Service
- While targeting 7 specific learning outcomes, students learn to become more caring, risk-taking, balanced, and internationally-minded global citizens



- Students are only able to take two sciences

 this means that students cannot take all three during day school





IB Programme Fees

\$3,000.00 Total

- \$250 in grade 9
 - the grade 9 fee is payable at time of acceptance of offer of admission
- \$350 in grade 10
- \circ \$1,200.00 per year in Grade 11 and Grade 12
- These fees cannot be used as tax deductions

- Incidentals as needed for the Programme











Personal Profile Form Tips

- It is suggested that students read over the questions and take time to consider responses before completing them on the form
- It may be helpful to draft ideas in another platform before entering them into the Google Form

 Students who are applying from outside of the YRDSB will receive an email after the application window closes with instructions about how to upload a scanned copy of the Grade 8 Progress Report.






Admissions Decisions

- Individual results and/or standing will not be released
- Submitting an application indicates that you understand and will adhere to this policy





Register through EDSBY









- When you click the registration tab to apply for the IB Programme, you will be directed to log into your existing YRDSB EDSBY account or to create a new EDSBY account.
- There will be step-by-step instructions available to help you create the account and register for the IB admissions process.





- Many of you have been invited by your YRDSB elementary schools to establish an EDSBY account.
 - If you have an account, you will be able to login and register directly for the IB admissions assessment.
- If you have been invited by your elementary school but have not yet activated your account, please do so. It will simplify your process.





- If you have **not yet been invited** by your YRDSB elementary school to establish an account *or* if you **do not have an account** because you are not currently a YRDSB parent, please follow the link provided on the YRDSB or school IB web page and **create a new account** when prompted and then **complete registration**.
- Tip: Please be sure to use an email address you regularly check so that you receive all messages from your admissions team.
