Common mistakes for Course Selection to avoid:

- Submitting course selection without parent/guardian approval
- Submitting course selection without 3 APPROPRIATE alternates
- Submitting course selection without a full course load (8 courses for grades 9 11, 6 courses for grade 12)
- Submitting course selection without completing the summer school plan for compulsory courses

Transcripts **printed ONCE per week (Fridays)**

Transcripts are an official record of Ontario secondary school credit courses that you have completed. Transcripts do not show courses you are currently enrolled in. Transcripts should only be requested for post-secondary education institutions (outside of Ontario), Canadian citizenship and for scholarships. **If you need to request a transcript, please email your guidance coursellor**. Transcripts will be printed only once per week, every Friday. Please plan your requests accordingly as we will not be printing them on various days.
