Semester 2 Timetables

Due to the ongoing nature of the pandemic, there has been considerable movement between adaptive and virtual platforms. As a result of the movement between the two platforms, all YRDSB high schools are in the process of re-timetabling semester 2. This means timetables for semester 2 have not been confirmed. What is on myBlueprint is not an accurate snapshot of your semester 2 timetable. During the month of January, the school will be working to re-timetable the school. Guidance is unable to answer questions about semester 2 timetables or course changes until timetables are finalized. Students will be informed when timetables are finalized. Thank you for your patience.
