Summer School Clarification

There are two types of summer school: **Summer eLearning** and **Secondary Summer School (In-class)**. Due to COVID-19 the **Secondary Summer School** is now also online. If you are already registered, you do NOT need to reregister and you cannot be registered in both. Please note that you may receive an email stating the location has changed for summer school. Since the courses are being delivered online, the school sites are being used for administrative purpose only. Location does not matter.

For those who have yet to register for summer school, there are two kinds: **Summer eLearning** and **Secondary Summer School**. Students can register in only **ONE** not both. You will be taken out of one if you attempt to register in both platforms.

1. **Secondary Summer School** (Acceleration, Reinforcement, Credit Recovery / Differentiated Support) - registration online through [myPathwayPlanner](#) open until June 26.
2. **Summer School e-Learning** - students [apply](#) online until June 25. Students **MUST** email their Guidance Counsellor for approval for summer e-Learning after you have registered or you will lose the registration.

Credit Upgrade in Summer School

YRDSB is offering credit upgrade for Grade 11 and 12 Math, Science, English courses. These courses are offered in the first 2 weeks of July (Session 1) and for students who have passed the course. This credit upgrade mark will show up twice on the credit counselling summary because of full disclosure. This means one will be a REPEAT. The upgrade can be obtained in 2 weeks which is half the time of our accelerated program.

To register, students must use [myPathwayPlanner](#). Once logged in, click *Continuing Education* and then click *Explore Courses*. Scroll to the bottom to *YRDSB Summer School* to find the courses

If you have already signed up for an accelerated (4 full weeks) summer school course, you cannot be registered in the upgrade as well.

For those students registered in the IB program this would be an OSSD credit only and cannot replace an SL or HL towards an IB Diploma. We are not preventing you from taking the upgrade; however, predicted grades for the IBO will be based only on work completed at Bayview, with your IB teachers.

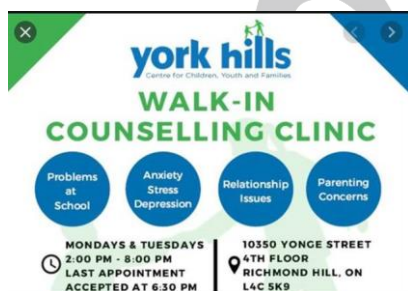

Important Information for Students Turning 18

Under the Education Act, parents/guardians have a right to access their child’s Ontario Student Record if the child is under 18.

If the student is 18 or over, the Board/school must follow the privacy provisions of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act regarding the disclosure of personal information about the student to their parents/guardians.

Students 18 or over must provide written permission by signing the [Consent for Information Sharing](#) form to allow parents/guardians to continue to access school-related information about the student. This includes academic progress, attendance and behaviour.
