Dual Credit Summer Courses

YRDSB are excited to offer **on-line Dual credit courses** this summer! Courses will be offered by Seneca, Centennial and Humber Colleges and will take place during the month of July. Course offerings, scheduling

details and more information can be found in our flyer: <http://bit.ly/summerdcflyer>. You do not need to be a student planning to go to college to take these courses. Students interested in animation, game design, baking, culinary, psychology, etc., all count as a high school credit.

How to register your students:

1. Ensure that the student meets the dual credit eligibility criteria: The primary focus group for summer dual credit courses is students needing a credit to graduate. Other applicants including SHSM and OYAP students will be considered but placed on a waiting list.
2. Students will complete an online application with their GAPPS account using the following link: bit.ly/yrdsbsummerdc. Once the student has been approved, they will receive a copy of their completed application in their GAPPS email

Important Information for Students Turning 18

Under the Education Act, parents/guardians have a right to access their child’s Ontario Student Record if the child is under 18.

If the student is 18 or over, the Board/school must follow the privacy provisions of the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act regarding the disclosure of personal information about the student to their parents/guardians.

Students 18 or over must provide written permission by signing the [Consent for Information Sharing](#) form to allow parents/guardians to continue to access school-related information about the student. This includes academic progress, attendance and behaviour.
