Queen's Major Admission Awards - Queen's Chancellor's Scholarship

Students who demonstrate superior academic ability, creative and original thinking, involvement in school or community activities, and proven leadership can apply for a Queen's major admission award. To be considered for the major admission awards, students must apply for admission to Queen's on OUAC no later than November 20th to ensure that you gain access to SOLUS to submit your MAA application.

If you are interested in the Queen's Chancellor's Scholarship, the applicant must receive nomination from Bayview Secondary School. If you are interested in being nominated, please submit your application to Mrs. Jarrett, <u>Keri.Jarrett@yrdsb.ca</u>, by Friday, November 26th at 3:00 pm. Students will be required to complete the MAA application, including a Credit Counselling summary (CCS) and letter of reference if nominated. For the purpose of submission to Mrs. Jarrett, the MAA application will be the only thing submitted (no need to submit the CCS or letter of reference). US Applications

If you are applying to the US for Regular Decision ONLY, you must complete the <u>google form</u> by November 1 by 3:00 pm. You will be contacted by the guidance counsellor who will support your application by November 3rd. Students should not approach teachers for predicted marks, your guidance counsellor will do this for you.

Transcripts **printed ONCE per week (Fridays)**

Transcripts are an official record of Ontario secondary school credit courses that you have completed. Transcripts do not show courses you are currently enrolled in. Transcripts should only be requested for post-secondary education institutions (outside of Ontario), Canadian citizenship and for scholarships. **If you need to request a transcript, please email your guidance counsellor**. Transcripts will be printed only once per week, every Friday. Please plan your requests accordingly as we will not be printing them on various days.
