- Grade 9 Conference will be on Oct 1 Will be held at Camp Green Acres; opportunity for the Grade 9 students to meet teachers and other grade 9 students; become more comfortable with BSS; Skill Builder tryouts took place and chose final listing today during student council meeting and will release names soon; last day to pay is Sept 24
- Semiformal will be on Nov 14

C. Principal's Report:

Presenter: Ms. Arlene Higgins-Wright

- Introduced Mr. Clayden (VP), Mr. Ishiguro (VP was dept. head at Bill Crothers, moved to Middlefield as acting VP; loves the diversity of admin team and the diverse experience), Ms. Sadacharan (VP – Stacy is new to BSS and received a warm welcome, good community, head of science and ELL support at Alex Mac, VP at Richmond Hill High)
- Stats enrolment is 1667 with many walk-ins (95 more), but some did not return; 105 teaching staff
- SHSM programs (business, health & wellness), autism community classes, IB
- Clubs 62 in total with more coming; information will be posted on website
- Athletics soccer, field hockey, cross country, swimming, co-ed tennis, etc. for the Fall
- Courses & timetables guidance is working on courses for semester 2
- Staffing fully staff with 105 teachers, hired 5 LTOs (long term supply teachers); received additional sections/classes and will hire for those
- Will be spending time on professional learning, assessment/evaluation to support students in other ways (well being, resilience, equity, etc) this is part of Mr. Ishiguro's portfolio; timetable is Brad's; Stacy's is traffic
- Communication tools website, parent bulleting, teach assist, gaps accounts

Parent Questions:

- Would 5 classes in a row be doable Ms. Higgins-Wright responded no as students need a break
- For students who have lunch in period 4 (starts at 12:45), but cafeteria is closed at 1:45 Ms. Higgins-Wright recommends students go to cafeteria earlier
- Mr. Ishiguro handles students A-K, Mr. Clayden K-R, Ms. Sadacharan S-Z
- Pathways Night is new in order to respond to questions from parents last year (Stacy has oversight)
- Oct 16 Parent's Night
- Impact of provincial budget cuts (ex. students were asked to print their own course packs in math teachers were asked by admin not to print; not mandatory for student to print, but can use soft copy as reference; not a direct impact from the cuts, but more a mandate from the school
- March break European trip still pending approval
- Students can start a club at any point in time, and require a school staff supervisor
