### Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) Requirements

Students must review My Pathway Planner and Ontario Student Status sheet to ensure they have completed all the diploma requirements.

#### **To Graduate:**

- 30 credits:
  - 18 Compulsory Credits and 12 Elective Credits
- Community Involvement:
  - 40 hours. If you do NOT have your Community Involvement completed, do so by March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
- OSSLT (literacy test):
  - If you have not passed the test, you should be enrolled in the OLC4O class
- 2 Online Asynchronous Courses
  - Complete 2 courses or fill out the Opt Out and submit to Guidance
- 34 Credit Threshold:
  - You may return for a 5<sup>th</sup> year, only if you do not exceed a total of 34 credits in that school year. This also includes Private School courses. Please consult with Guidance as students must get permission to return.

<sup>\*\*</sup> In groups 1, 2 and 3, a maximum of 2 credits in French as a Second Language can count as compulsory credits, one from group 1 and one from either group 2 or group 3.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> A maximum of 2 credits in Cooperative Education can count as compulsory credits.

<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup> Families who wish to opt out their child from the Online Learning graduation requirement should speak to their child's school.

<sup>†</sup> The 12 optional credits may include up to 4 credits earned through approved Dual Credit courses.

A Student's achieving an OSSD Red Seal Specialist High Skills Major (SHSM) diploma will have additional requirements based on their particular program.

## **Researching Ontario Universities**

- Visit Ontario Universities Info (OUInfo)
- Find a post-secondary pathway that works best for you. Consider your marks, the school and campus, programs, location and parent approval
- Review university websites for info
- Plan to visit campuses Open Houses.
- OUAC Application <u>Site</u>
- January 15, 2024: Latest date to submit completed online applications to the OUAC for equal consideration.



### **Reporting to OUAC/OCAS**

- OSSD marks are sent at 5 submission times.
- Please review marks and credit count on OUAC/OCAS
- **ELL students** MUST research Language Proficiency Requirements and sign up to write a language test ASAP; Bayview does not submit those results
- Earning credits outside Bayview:
  - o If you are taking a course offered through YRDSB (i.e. summer/night school; e-learning; International Languages) these will be automatically reported to OUAC/OCAS
  - Any courses NOT offered through YRDSB such as RCM, non-YRDSB International Languages and courses through other school boards, please bring an official transcript/report card to Ms. Chen (Guidance Secretary)
  - o <u>Private School & non-YRDSB</u> private schools and other non-YRDSB schools MUST report the course on OUAC/OCAS and MUST submit the mark to OUAC/OCAS. **Bayview** will NOT submit the mark. After the course is completed, the other schools must mail the report card in a sealed envelope
- Schools such as McGill and UBC will pull your marks from OUAC. They will ask for your OUAC application number in your application to their school.

# **Ontario Colleges**

### **Researching Ontario Colleges**

- Ontario colleges use ONE site for both information on schools, programs and to apply: <a href="https://www.ontariocolleges.ca">www.ontariocolleges.ca</a>
- Early October 2023: Online Application Opens.
  - You may create an account and begin your application.
- November 1, 2023: Earliest Offer Date
  - This is the earliest date that colleges may begin to send offers of admission to programs. Offers will continue to be issued until programs are filled or wait-lists are established.
- February 1, 2024: Equal Consideration Date
  - Apply on or before this date in order to receive equal consideration for admission to programs starting the following fall. After this date, colleges consider applicants on a first-come, first-served basis until programs are full.



- Competitive Programs: Note that applications to Highly Competitive Programs MUST be received by this date in order to be considered. As these programs receive a high volume of applicants, all seats may be filled by February 1.
- Applicants are encouraged to complete their applications well before the Equal Consideration Date, as website volumes on the online application are at their highest at this time.
- Many programs continue to accept applicants after February 1.
   Use our Find a Program tool at any time to find programs that are still open.
- May 1, 2024: Deadline to Confirm Offers of Admission
- Applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by this date. Log in to your ontariocolleges.ca account to confirm your offer.
