**Apprenticeship** - is a combination of on-the-job training and classroom time that leads to a skill trade credential.

**College** - Programs provide a combination of academic and practical/technical skills training for a specific career

**University** - Programs provide theoretical and some practical training. Main areas of focus at most universities:

- STEM: Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics
- Business/Commerce
- Arts/Humanities/Social Sciences
