### Halloween – Guidelines for our Spirit Day on October 31st

Halloween brings memories to many of dress-up parades, costume competitions, and classroom parties for some members of our community and carries a very different meaning for others. It is important for us to recognize that not all families celebrate and participate in Halloween. The reasons for not participating may include cultural beliefs, faith, socioeconomic status, and personal reasons

We will be having a school Spirit Day on October 31st led by our Colour Captains:

- Students may wear a costume to school or wear Fall colours, to earn a point for their colour team.
- Students should not wear masks that cover their full face, as it is dangerous to walk around/see safely in the hallway/on the stairs
- No replica weapons of any kind are allowed (ex. swords, grenades, guns, knives...)
- Costumes should be school appropriate and in line with our safe schools and inclusivity policy.
  - Costumes must not mimic or replicate any cultural or religious groups
  - Costumes must not be violent or bloody

   DO NOT SEND FOOD ITEMS TO SCHOOL with your child. They will be returned home.
- Weather permitting, we will have an inside-outside circle parade on the tarmac around 11:15am so that students can see each other's costumes and Fall colours.
