1. Welcome/Introductions:

3. Principal's and Teacher's Report:

Sandy and Melissa (Teachers' representative) gave a short report on the various activities within the school

- Student leadership committees for Grades 6-8: 120 students have joined 6 committees (Equity and Inclusivity, Mental Health and Well-being, School Spirit & Ambassadors, Fundraising, Media and Communications and Athletics)
- Grade 8 music band has started
- Healthy Schools Student Club initiative has started
- Ongoing activities include cross-country running and flag football
- Terry Fox run/walk will be held on September 28, 2023 (Thursday) and the Truth and Reconciliation day on September 29, 2023 (Friday)
- Grade 6 to go on a field trip to Toronto Holocaust Museum on October 4-5, 2023
- Workshop on discrimination and bias by Tour for Humanity Friends of Simon Wiesenthal was conducted for Grade 8
- Curriculum night and associated planning was discussed (details below)

4. Curriculum night:

To be held on October 30, 2023. This year the curriculum night to include one hour (5pm – 6pm) of social activities with a pizza booth, cookies booth, school council booth, Richmond Hill Public Library (RHPL) booth and dancing/movement activity zone by Grade 8. School council to help with arranging volunteers to support the pizza and cookie selling activities – total of 4 volunteers for pizza and cookie booths and 1 volunteer for RHPL booth. To increase participation and awareness of the curriculum night, it was suggested that announcing the curriculum night and activities within the classes and getting kids engaged in the evening would be helpful. After the social activities (from 6pm onwards) parents and kids can go meet the teachers and have an informal chat with the teachers/administration.

- Community engagement: Adopting hybrid mode of school council meetings might encourage more participation. Alternating the meetings with in-person and online meetings would be helpful. Ideas such as having in class announcements on the various activities by council and/or engaging kids within classrooms on parent/community participation in council may help boost involvement were discussed. School council will have a volunteer form and other details available at the curriculum night council booth as well.
- Pizza lunch: Tharshini scouted other options for pizza lunch for the upcoming semester in 2024 and provided
 everyone present with pepperoni and cheese pizza slices from Papa Jones as tasters. Based on the popularity
 and number of participants for the current pizza lunch program, a decision on changing the pizza for the next
 year will be taken in the upcoming council meetings
